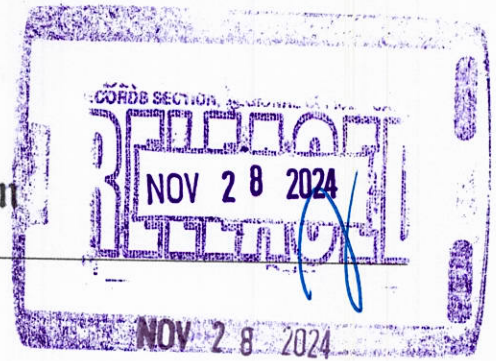

ADMINISTRATION OF PISA FAMILIARITY TEST THROUGH KHAN
ACADEMY AND CONDUCT OF ONSITE MONITORING
ON 2025 PISA PREPARATIONS

1. Relative to the preparations for the 2025 Programme for International Student Assessment, a PISA Familiarity Test using Khan Academy PISA Frontlearners Test (online) will be administered from December 5-6, 9-10, 2024 (testing window). All schools verified and recommended for inclusion in the 2025 PISA potential school participants (see Enclosure A) are required to administer the PISA Frontlearners Test. While the rest of the public and private secondary schools are enjoined to take the said familiarity test.
2. The activity aims to improve the readiness of the learners for the 2025 PISA main survey.
3. All secondary school heads must designate one (1) ICT Support Staff and one (1) Lead Proctor for the said test. All Division Testing Coordinators (DTCs), secondary school heads, school ICT Support Staff, school Lead Proctors, division and regional monitors are required to attend an online orientation on December 3, 2024, 1:00 PM at <https://bit.ly/FrontlearnersTest>
4. The test platform provides a Course Challenge percentage that describes the mean percentage score of the takers. This shall be recorded by the proctors using the template found in Enclosure B and shall be submitted to the DTCs. The DTCs shall consolidate the reports using a template found in Enclosure C and shall be submitted to the Regional Testing Coordinator on or before December 13, 2024.
5. Regional and division monitors shall conduct an onsite monitoring on the said dates using the monitoring tool found in Enclosure D. The regional monitors and their assigned SDOs are reflected in the table below:

 - Teacher PISA Training and Collaborative Expertise
 - PISA Integration in Classroom Instruction
 - Stakeholders' Support to PISA Preparations
 - Issues, Actions Taken, and Recommendations on PISA Preparation
7. The DTCs shall arrange the itinerary of the regional monitors, and shall submit the said itinerary to the RTC on or before November 3, 2024. The monitoring tool to be used is found in Enclosure D.
8. The expenses for the administration of PISA Familiarity Test, and travel expenses of the monitors shall be charged against the program support funds for the provision of test and learning materials for the PISA Science Program (OSEC-13-24-6285) downloaded to the SDOs or through local funds subject to usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is highly desired.
