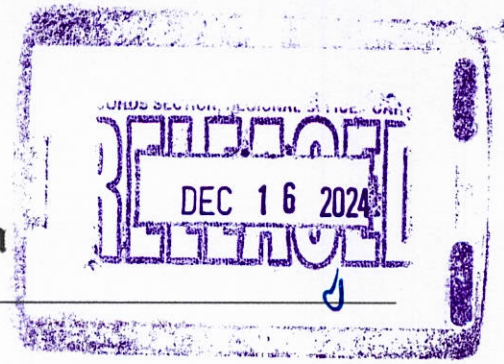

CALL FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE PROGRAM CONVERGENCE BUDGETING
FOR THE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS (PCB-SDG)
FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2026

1. The field is hereby informed that the National Economic and Development Authority, as secretariat to the Development Budget Coordination Committee Sub-Committee on Sustainable Development Goals (SC-SDG), invites eligible entities to submit proposals for the PCB-SDG for FY 2026.
2. Participating agencies are requested to submit proposals that address regressing SDG targets and indicators, or those that need acceleration, and are aligned with Philippine Development Plan 2023-2028.
3. Proposals must be submitted by January 17, 2025, along with the required forms, supporting documents, and a cover letter addressed to the NEDA Secretary, signed by the head of the participating agency.

**SUBJECT : Call for Proposals for the Program Convergence Budgeting
for the Sustainable Development Goals (PCB-SDG) for Fiscal
Year (FY) 2026**

DATE : November 13, 2024

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1. In preparation for the FY 2026 Budget Call, the National Economic and Development Authority Central Office (NEDA CO), as Secretariat to the Development Budget Coordination Committee Sub-Committee on Sustainable Development Goals (SC-SDG), is now accepting proposals for programs and projects (PAPs) that may be funded under the FY 2026 PCB-SDG.
 2. Participating government agencies are requested to submit proposals that address regressing SDG targets and indicators or those that need acceleration and are aligned with the Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2023-2028.
 3. In the preparation of proposals, participating government agencies are advised to undertake the following:
 - 3.1 Prior to submission, identify other applicable PCBs before deciding to enroll in the PCB-SDG. The government is implementing various PCBs such as the PCB on Water Sector and on Zero Hunger which support PAPs in the water sector, and address hunger respectively; and
 - 3.2 Engage members of the SC-SDG's Stakeholders Chamber in the planning, preparation of the proposals, implementation of the PAPs, and/or follow-through processes. Premium points will be given to proposals incorporating this form of engagement.
 4. This call is made in light of the Amended PCB Framework for SDGs and its Implementing Guidelines, which is anchored on Section 9 of Republic Act No. 11467 which mandates the allocation of 20 percent of the total revenues collected from excise taxes on alcohol, heated tobacco products (HTPs), and vapor products (vapes) for the attainment of the SDGs.

5. The PCB-SDG was put in place to ensure a holistic approach in steering better domestic resource flows amidst limited fiscal space toward accelerating the implementation and attainment of the country's SDG commitment. It is also intended to promote synergistic partnerships and collaboration by leveraging stakeholder engagement and resources for the SDGs.
6. Participating agencies must accomplish and submit all PCB-SDG forms and supporting documents to the SC-SDG Secretariat on or before January 17, 2025, at 5:00 PM via email at sdg@neda.gov.ph (cc: &GOVS-drd@neda.gov.ph). The submission must include a cover letter, which is addressed to the NEDA Secretary and signed by the head of the participating agency.

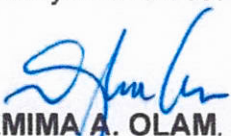
