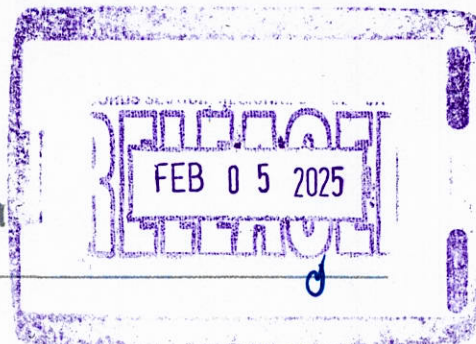

4. solicit and increase commitment from the partners of the Regular and Milk Component; and
5. discuss the follow through activities after the suppliers' expo and mapping.
