2025 CARAGA REGIONAL ATHLETIC GAMES

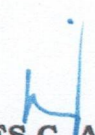
1. Republic Act No. 10588, or the Palarong Pambansa Act of 2013, declares that it is the policy of the State to promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions and amateur sports, including training for international competitions. This is to foster self-discipline, teamwork and excellence in developing a healthy and alert citizenry through the institutionalization of the Palarong Pambansa as the country's premier national sporting event.
2. To select the qualifiers for the 2025 Palarong Pambansa which will be held in May 2025 in Ilocos Norte, DepEd Caraga will conduct the **2025 Caraga Regional Athletic Games (CaRAGa)** from **March 30 – April 4, 2025**, at Nasipit, Agusan del Norte.

4. The Regional Office shall download the incidental expenses of Technical Officials. However, SDOs are requested to support the necessary needs of the Technical Officials.
5. Furthermore, SDO Agusan del Norte will be responsible for the hotel accommodation of DepEd CO ExeCom, Palarong Pambansa Secretariat and invited guests, while SDO Butuan City will provide their transportation and assign protocol officers throughout the event.
6. Travel expenses of all participants shall be charged to local funds, subject to standard accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Compensatory Time Off (CTO) shall be granted to teaching, non-teaching, and teaching-related personnel in accordance with the Civil Service Commission and Department of Budget and Management Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 (Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered).

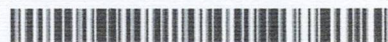

BEST IN SALUDO MECHANICS AND CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

- The contest shall be open to all participating athletic delegations in the region.
- Each participating athletic delegation shall render and entrance in marching cadence to the accompaniment of their provincial/city/division hymn/ march from the designated starting point bringing the prescribed delegation banner for identification.
- Actual saludo performance shall be executed for a maximum of 2 minutes (excluding entrance and exit). If the performance exceeds 2 minutes, it is automatically disqualified from the contest.
- Any musical accompaniment is allowed during the actual performance.
- Stunt movements such as cartwheels, front and back rolls and formations such as pyramids are strictly prohibited.
- The use of caps, gloves and other hand props are allowed during the performance. Use of oversized props (>1.5 meters) are prohibited.
- Pyrotechnics, fire and fireworks display are prohibited before, during and after the saludo performance.
- A brief description / introduction of the delegation shall be read during the entrance and acknowledging the delegation officials and heads.

Criteria	Percentage
Uniformity of movements (mastery of movement / choreography and yells)	30%
Discipline (following the rules, alignment, coordination in marching and synchronization)	30%
Public display / show-off (visual impact to the presentation)	40%

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CRITERIA FOR THE MOST DISCIPLINED DELEGATION

1. Adherence to Codes of Conduct (30 points):

- Respect for Event Rules and Regulations (20 points):
 - Proper adherence to event rules (on time, no cheating, proper conduct).
 - Cooperation with event organizers and officials.
- Respect for Other Delegations (10 points):
 - Positive interactions with other teams (no disparaging remarks, no negative behavior).
 - Sportsmanship and encouragement of other delegations.

2. Clean and Green Practices (25 points):

- Pre-Event "Green Audit" (10 points):
 - Delegation's commitment to eco-friendly practices as evidenced by their billeting preparations.
 - Proper waste segregation, water/electricity conservation plans.
- During the Event (15 points):
 - Active participation in clean and green initiatives (e.g., waste segregation, avoiding single-use plastics).
 - Compliance with waste management guidelines and energy conservation efforts.

3. Opening Ceremony Decorum (25 points):

- Appearance and Punctuality (15 points):
 - Uniforms are appropriate, and all members arrive on time.
 - Delegation is organized and neatly presented.
- Respectful Behavior During the Ceremony (10 points):
 - Full participation in the ceremony with no disruptions (e.g., no phones, no talking).
 - Active engagement in the ceremony and a demonstration of respect for national symbols.

4. Behavior and Sportsmanship (20 points):

- Respect for Opponents and Officials (10 points):
 - Display of sportsmanship during and after events (no inappropriate celebrations, respectful gestures).
 - Supportive behavior towards other delegations and officials.
- Compliance with Event Schedules (10 points):
 - Punctuality in attending all scheduled events, including competitions, meetings, and ceremonies.
 - Respect for venue rules and no disruptive behavior (e.g., no noise, no unnecessary movement during matches).



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
