This activity aims to provide technical assistance to the identified schools to enhance the implementation of Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (GPP). Specifically, it seeks to:

- check the schools' compliance with the DepEd guidelines and standards on the establishment, maintenance, and utilization of school gardens;

- strengthen stakeholder's collaboration for sustainable GPP implementation; and
- provide actionable recommendations based on monitoring findings.

All schools to be visited shall prepare a presentation (approximately five minutes) showing the status of their GPP implementation, notable best practices, and the school's GPP journey—from inception, through implementation, to sustainability. These presentations will be shared during the feedbacking activity on September 5, 2025. The said schools shall also prepare their respective GPP documents and Means of Verifications (MOVs) during the scheduled monitoring activity.

7. Feedbacking Activity:

The Municipal Agriculturist of Tagbina, all School Heads or School GPP coordinator and Public Schools District Supervisor (PSDS) of the schools visited and the schools within Tagbina 1 and 2 districts, are requested to participate on the Feedbacking Activity at Maglambing Integrated School on September 5, 2025 at 9:00 a.m.

Travel expenses and per diem for the involved personnel shall be charged against Learner Support Program (OSEC-13-25-03476), MOOE, School Based Feeding Program (SBFP), or GPP Program Support Funds (PSF), subject to government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
