CONDUCT OF THE QUARTER 3 FEEDBACK SURVEY
FOR GBF CLASS BUILDER IMPLEMENTERS

1. In support of the ongoing implementation of the **Gokongwei Brothers Foundation (GBF) Class Builder Program**, the Department of Education – Caraga Region, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), informs the field of the **Quarter 3 (Q3) Feedback Survey for Grades 3–6 Mathematics teachers and Key Stage 1 ARAL Reading Remediation tutors** who are **enrolled in GBF Class Builder**. - b. **Identify strengths, gaps, and immediate support needs** in the delivery of GBF Class Builder interventions in Mathematics and ARAL Reading.
- c. **Strengthen evidence-based decision-making** for continuous program improvement at the school, SDO, and regional levels.
- d. **Ensure 100% compliance** of all concerned implementers with survey submission to establish a complete regional picture of implementation status.
