



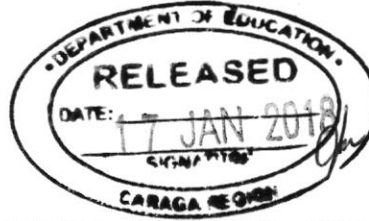

**ADDENDUM/CORRIGENDUM TO REGIONAL MEMORANUM NO. 565, S. 2017
RE: 21ST CARAGA REGIONAL ATHLETIC MEET (CRAM)**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Asst. Schools Division Superintendents
This Region

1. The Department of Education Caraga Region shall conduct the 21st Caraga Regional Athletic Meet (CRAM) on February 24- March 1, 2018 at Butuan City and Agusan del Norte with DepEd Region as Host.
2. The DepEd Division Offices shall be responsible for the preparation and participation of their respective delegations, while the regional office shall be responsible for the preparation of the playing facilities, billeting quarters of the 12 divisions and officiating officials coming from the different divisions of the region and venue for the games secretariat.
3. The objectives of the 21st Caraga Regional Athletic Meet (CRAM) are to:
 - a. select the best and potential athletes, coaches and chaperons for the 2018 Palarong Pambansa;
 - b. improve the over-all performance of Caraga Delegation to the 2018 Palarong Pambansa in Vigan City, Ilocos Sur from Rank 14 to Rank 9; and
 - c. showcase the values inherent in sports, such as: sportsmanship, teamwork, discipline, nationalism and patriotism.
4. The Regional Office shall take charge of the CRAM games administration and management together with the 12 division PESS Supervisors. Each division shall recommend officiating officials who are physically fit, and must be 50 years old and below except for the Tournament Managers who have attended the 2017 regional sports officiating refresher course. All recommended officiating officials shall be subjected to verification and validation of the tournament manager to be approved by the regional office.
5. The 21st CRAM officiating officials shall be provided with meals and snacks in a Payroll System at P 175.00 per day for six (6) days, uniform and certificates of recognition, while travelling expenses from station to Butuan City and vice versa shall be charged against the Local/MOOE/SEF/PTA Funds and other available sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
