CONDUCT OF THE KAAGAPAY PROGRAM HOMEROOM
AND GUIDANCE WORKSHOP

1. In support of the Department of Education's implementation of the Strengthened Senior High School (SSHS) Program, this Office announces the conduct of the Kaagapay Program Homeroom and Guidance Workshop for the 26 identified SSHS pilot public schools for SY 2025-2026 across the participating Schools Division Offices (SDOs).
2. The Kaagapay Program is a national capacity-building initiative designed to support and empower parents, guardians, caregivers, and those entrusted with the responsibility for the upbringing of a child-learner as partners in the holistic development of public school learners.
3. The implementation of the Kaagapay Program shall be carried out through evidence-based and partnership-supported approach workshops and advocacy campaigns that will cover the core components such as Orientation and Context Setting, Competency-Based Learning Sessions, Application and Reflection Workshops, and Community Commitment and Sustainability Planning.
4. Each Schools Division Office shall organize at least one Kaagapay Training targeting an average of 30-50 participants composed of parents, guardians, caregivers, and those entrusted with the responsibility for the upbringing of a child-learner, preferably from the SSHS pilot public schools previously downloaded with the Program Support Fund for the printing of the Landas Toolkit.
5. Expenses incurred in relation to the conduct of the training shall be charged to the downloaded Program Support Funds (PSF) for the Kaagapay Program (Homeroom and Guidance Workshops) subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
