



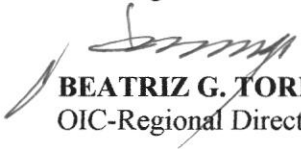

The Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP) Inc. will conduct the 2018 National Children's Science Congress with the theme Enhancing Knowledge in Conducting Science Investigations from February 7 to 9, 2018 at the La Vista Resort Complex, Pansol, Calamba, Laguna.

The congress aims to:

1. provide the participants with effective medium in the development of Science and Technology concepts;
2. undertake Science activities, which will enhance creativity, understanding and exchange of novel ideas among them;
3. promote academic excellence through scientific research;
4. instill in the minds of the participants an atmosphere of sound competition and camaraderie;
5. give recognition to the winners of science investigatory projects and other contests; and
6. conduct assembly of the Science Club Advisers for the election of new leaders.

The target participants are learners and science teachers from both public and private schools teaching in Special Science and Laboratory Schools, and who are winners of Category A (all First Place Regional Winners), Category B (all Second and Third Place Regional Winners), and Category C (all First and Second Place Division Winners).
