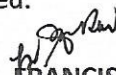

This Region

1. Cognizant to Memorandum No. DM-CI-2019-00-120 by Asec. Alma Ruby C. Torio dated May 02, 2019, the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) shall conduct the Sanayguro: National Teachers Training Program of Level One (1) Teachers on Arts and Culture for the Special Program in the Arts (SPA) in six art disciplines on May 20-24, 2019 in Bacolod City.

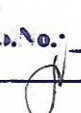

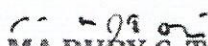
