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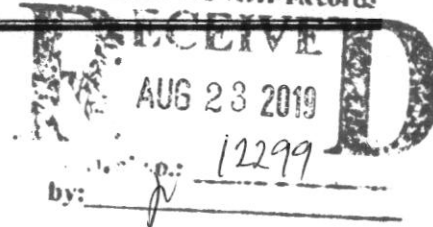


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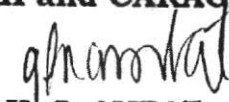

“Analysis on the Barriers to Access and Learning of Vulnerable Adolescents in the Philippines”

GUIDELINES ON IDENTIFICATION OF RESPONDENTS:

Considering that one of the objectives of the study is to measure the progress towards achieving the targets results that can be generated, it is imperative that participants (refer to Table 1 for number of participants per region) are selected to create a non-bias and balance reporting of outcomes.

The inclusion criteria for the ALS learners include:

- 12 – 19 years old enrolled and completed the ALS program completers and passed the A & E
- 12 – 19 years old enrolled and completed the ALS program but did not pass the A & E Test
- 12 – 19 years old enrolled and completed the ALS program but did not take the A & E Test
- 12 – 19 years old who enrolled and dropped out of the ALS program

The Out of School Youth (OSY) include:

- 12 - 19 years old who dropped out of school
- Have not enrolled in the ALS Program
- Have not finished post-secondary course
- Have no gainful work or employment ☐ Willing to participate in the study

The mobile teachers, ALS program implementers and other stakeholders include:

DepEd Delivered (ALS is delivered by DepEd personnel)

- Mobile Teacher
- Full-Time District ALS Coordinators
- Part-Time District ALS Coordinators
- Division ALS Supervisor

DepEd Procured (ALS is delivered by non-DepEd personnel or groups who are contracted by DepEd)

- Literacy Volunteers
- Instructional Managers (Service Provider)
- Instructional Manager (BP-OSA-Balik Paaralan para sa Out of School Adults)

Non-DepEd Financed/Partner (ALS is delivered by non-DepEd personnel or groups using other sources of funds)

- Instructional Manager (individual)
- Instructional Manager (organization, faith-based) Specify Organization:
- LGU Official/Employee.

The mobile teachers and ALS Implementers must have:

- Knowledge of the information needed based on the interview questions
- At least two years of experience in the ALS program

In case where there are many participants that will fit in the inclusion criteria, simple random sampling will be used to select the participants from the sample population taken from the list of ALS learners and OSY provided by ALS focal person. The ALS focal persons in each study area will be consulted in the selection of the participants to ensure that the target samples are properly identified.
