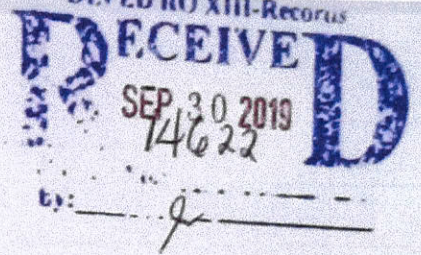

The National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) will conduct the **2019 International Conference on Cultural Statistics and Creative Economy (ICCSCE)** with the theme, **Cultural Statistics and Creative Economy as Drivers of Cultural Development**, from **October 14 to 15, 2019** at the Waterfront Hotel, Lahug, Cebu City.

 - a. push for the appreciation and utilization of cultural statistics as a tool in establishing data on creative economy and measures of development;
