2018 SINING PAMBANSA ACTIVITIES

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 20.s, 2018, the Department of Education(DepEd) in partnership with National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCAA), the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), the Technical Education Skills Development Authority (TESDA) and the National Music Competition for Young Artists Inc. (NAMCYA), announces the holding of the 2018 Sining Pambansa with the theme Sining Pangkabuhayan Para Sa Kabataan comprising a series of activities from February to May 2018.

2. The Sining Pambansa activities includes regional street dance parade, plenary sessions, art camps, performances, workshops, exhibits, awarding and recognition of various artists, among others, to wit:

3. The Sining Pambansa is open to teachers and students from both public and private secondary schools, senior high schools offering Special Program in the Arts (SPA), IPED, ALIVE, ALS, and schools of living traditions. In addition, DepEd field officials, particularly the regional/division/school SPA coordinators are strongly advised and encourage to attend.

4. A maximum of 50 participants per region only, its composition shall come from the SPA/Arts and Design Track specialization(dance, music, media arts, visual arts, theatre, etc.).

5. The Travelling expenses, and registration of Fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (1,500.00) per delegate shall be collected to defray overhead expenses and management cost, shall be charged against school MOOE, SEF, PTA and other local available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The first meal will be dinner of March 6 (Day 0) and the last meal will be lunch on March 10, 2018 (Day 4).

6. The Regional Director, Schools Division Superintendents and School Principals are expected to send their respective delegations, and are requested to confirm their region's participation on or before February 31, 2018, by sending the enclosed pre-registration form indicating the names and required data, through mail or fax to the Office of the Undersecretary for External Partnership at telefax (02) 633-1940.
7. Student-participants may be given additional merits for their attendance to the Sining Pambansa activities in co-curricular activities for students graduating and running for honors. They shall be given reasonable time to make up and comply with other requirements in the different subject areas, including but not limited to quizzes and other examinations that they will miss.
8. School officials and teachers as accredited members of the national/regional working committees shall be granted vacation sick leave credits pursuant to the provisions of DepEd Order 53.s, 2003.
9. All regions shall adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 40,s, 2012 entitled Child Protection Policy.

**2018 SINING PAMBANSA ORGANIZATION, GENERAL INFORMATION
AND GUIDELINES**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), in partnership with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), and the National Music Competitions for Young Artists Foundation Inc. (NAMCYA), announces the holding of the 2018 *Sining Pambansa* with the theme *Sining Pangkabuhayan Para sa Kabataan* to be comprised of a series of activities from February to May 2018. This is consistent with Article 2, Section 17 and Article 14, Sections 14-18 of the 1987 Constitution and with Agenda 6 of the DepEd Ten-Point Agenda.
2. The activities shall be hosted by DepEd Regions V (Bicol) and XIII (Caraga), in coordination with their respective City/Local Governments, Department of Tourism (DOT), TESDA, DTI, and the NCCA.
3. The activities aim to:
 - a. strengthen awareness and appreciation of the nation's rich cultural heritage;
 - b. demonstrate positive attitude through active participation in plenary sessions, workshops, performances, exhibits of outputs, and parade; and
 - c. preserve, promote, and develop authentic Filipino culture, arts and crafts as a way of life and livelihood.
4. *Sining Pambansa* activities shall include regional street dance parade, plenary sessions, art camps, performances, workshops, exhibits, awarding and recognition of various artists, among others.

5. The activities are scheduled as follows:

6. The *Sining Pambansa* is open to teachers and students from both public and private secondary schools, senior high schools, schools offering Special Program in the Arts (SPA), Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd), Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE), Alternative Learning System (ALS), and schools of living traditions. In addition, DepEd field officials, particularly the regional/division/SPA coordinators are strongly advised and encouraged to attend.

7. The DepEd National Organizing Committee (NOC) shall be chaired by the Undersecretary for External Partnerships. The NOC, through its chair, shall designate the members of the various working committees. The members of the NOC and the various working committees shall be comprised of personnel from the central and regional offices, representatives from government partners, and the Regional Culture and Arts Coordinators (RCAC) and/or the regional SPA supervisors/coordinators.

8. The RCAC and regional SPA supervisors/coordinators are required to attend all planning meetings/conferences, workshops, opening and closing programs, and the awarding ceremonies. Those who fail to attend due to equally important matters should send their respective representatives.

9. The members of the working committees, RCAC and Regional SPA supervisors/coordinators are required to have an approved travel authority duly signed by their respective heads of office for the conduct of the *Sining Pambansa*.

10. The NOC, through its chair, is authorized to make necessary management actions and decisions in the conduct of *Sining Pambansa*. The host regions shall handle all financial, administrative, and operational matters relative to the holding of the said event. The NOC, together with the host regions, shall provide the technical management and operational services.

11. The board and lodging, supplies and materials, honoraria of speakers, event kits, prizes, sounds and lights rentals, transportation, including travel expenses of DepEd NOC and the members of the working committees and other related and incidental expenses shall be charged to downloaded funds. The prizes/awards for

the *Gawad Parangal sa Sining* may come from other sources such as grants and sponsorships.

12. The registration fee and travel expenses of the regional delegation shall be charged to local funds, including, but not limited to school/division/regional/PTCA funds, School Board Funds, and other sources subject to the usual DepEd accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

13. Attendance of RCACs is required to lead their regional delegations. Each region should be represented by **not more than 50 participants** only. The RCACs shall be responsible in identifying the composition of their regional delegation as to performers/participants and officials from regions/schools divisions/schools. Attendance of the participants/regional delegations shall be **on official business**.

14. A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00) per delegate shall be charged to defray overhead expenses and management cost. The first meal will be dinner on February 6 (Day 0) and the last meal will be lunch on February 10, 2018 (Day 4).

15. Regional directors, schools division superintendents, and school principals are expected to send their respective delegations. The RCACs are requested to confirm their region's participation on or before **January 31, 2018**, by sending the enclosed Pre-Registration Form indicating the names and required data, through mail or fax to the Office of the Undersecretary for External Partnerships at telefax no. (02) 633-1940.

16. Student-participants may be given additional merits for their attendance to the *Sining Pambansa* Activities consistent with DepEd Orders regarding participation in co-curricular activities for students graduating and running for honors. They shall be given reasonable time to make up and comply with other requirements in the different subject areas, including but not limited to quizzes and other examinations that they will miss.

17. School officials and teachers as accredited members of the national/regional working committees shall be granted vacation leave credits pursuant to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers.

18. All regions shall adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 entitled DepEd Child Protection Policy. Hence, consistent with the said DepEd Order, the concerned officials shall be held responsible for the protection, welfare, and safety of their students. In addition, each DepEd RO shall provide medical insurance coverage for its delegation.
