1. In support of the Region's strategic intervention to strengthen the culture of Research among teaching and non-teaching personnel, a Three-Day In-House Paper Review for the Fourth Batch of Researches is set on April 4-6, 2018 at a venue to be announced later.
2. The ~~A~~ activity aims to:
 - a. conduct pilot test of CI Project Process of Assessment and Intensive Review (PAIR) on evaluating research proposals;
 - b. evaluate research proposals and assess needs and areas for improvement;
 - c. provide technical assistance to research proponents; and
 - d. develop the attitude of researchers toward research.
3. During the first day, the Regional Research Team and the Regional Pool of Data Analysts will have the blind paper review of the research proposals submitted. On the second and third days, the proponents will have their oral presentation of their research proposal.
4. Enclosed is the list of proponents for the 4th batch researches who will attend the aforementioned Paper Review as well as the Regional Research Team and the data analysts.
5. Participants' travel expenses and other incidental expenses shall be charged against division local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
