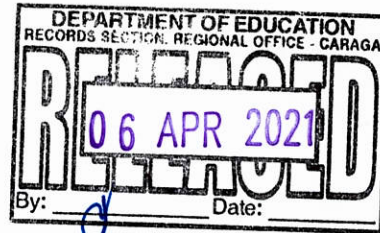

CONTEST GUIDELINES/MECHANICS

1. On the Spot Painting Contest
2. Canvas size must be 24 x 36 inches w/ frame
3. Only Acrylic or Oil paint shall be used.
4. Artist is given 8 hours only. No extension.
5. Performance shall be recorded via Google Meet Video teleconference
6. Inspection of Materials shall be conducted by the MAPEH Supervisor or contest administrator.
7. Only one (1) contest venue/room for every SDO, covered with video Recording Camera for 8 hours without interruptions.
8. SDO official entry shall be submitted to the region on or before April 13, 2021
9. No Coaching, spectators or parents are allowed at the contest venue.
10. The decision of the board of judges is final, no protest will be entertained.
11. The output of the participants shall be considered as the official property of the DepEd.
12. Awarding of winners will be done at the National Level only.
13. Regional Elimination is only a qualifying round, winners will receive a certificate of recognition and participation.
14. Categories :
 - 1 entry for Elementary learner
 - 1 entry for Secondary learner
 - 1 entry for Teacher's category
15. Regional Winners shall be the official Regional Entry to the National Arts Contest.

INVITATION TO JOIN THE NATIONAL ARTS CONTEST IN CELEBRATION
OF THE 65TH ANNIVERSARY OF PEACE TREATY BETWEEN
PHILIPPINES AND JAPAN

1. Pursuant to DM-OUCI-2020-416 dated December 29, 2020, the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) is inviting all DepEd Teachers and learners to participate in the National Arts Contest slated on May 2021 at DepEd Central Office, Pasig City with the theme "65TH Anniversary of Peace Treaty between Philippines and Japan".
2. The National Arts Contest will not only showcase the talents of both Filipino learners and teachers in the arts but more importantly, discover from their perspective, through their artworks, how they reflect on the depth of friendship between the two countries.
3. The Regional Elimination "**On the Spot Painting**" shall be held on April 7, 2021 (friday) via Google Meet from 8:00AM-5:00PM in 3 categories, namely: 1. Elementary learners category, 2. Secondary learners category, 3. Teachers Category, only 1 entry per SDO/category. There shall be only one (1) winner per category, and shall be the official regional entry to the National Arts Contest.
4. All entries/paintings shall be on canvas, with 24 x 36 inches frame, using only either acrylic or oil paint. The division MAPEH/SPA supervisor shall set-up the google meet link, video cameras, inspection of materials, and one (1) venue for the 8 hours actual performance on April 7, 2021 from 8:00AM to 5:00PM.
5. DepEd Caraga shall invite expert/artists from the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCAA) to judge the regional elimination via Google meet, the decision of the judges shall be final and executory, no protest shall be entertained.
6. The Champion at the National Level shall receive 500k while the 1st and 2nd runners up for each category shall receive 150k and 50k, respectively. Non-winners shall receive 3,000k each.
