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PRE-EMPTIVE MEASURE FOR TROPICAL DEPRESSION CRISING

Per Severe Weather Bulletin No. 1 issued by the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical, and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) on May 13, 2021 at 5:00am today, the Low-Pressure Area (LPA) over the Philippine sea east of Davao City has developed into **Tropical Depression Crising**.

All DepEd Offices and school personnel are hereby advised to conduct pre-emptive measures in their respective areas to reduce the possible impact of the weather disturbance that is forecasted to make its landfall in Surigao del Sur-Davao Oriental areas between tonight or tomorrow morning.

Moderate to heavy rains over Surigao del Sur, Agusan del Sur, Davao Oriental, Davao de Oro, and Davao del Norte will be experienced. Under these conditions, isolated to scattered flooding (including flash floods) and rain-induced landslides are possible during heavy or prolonged rainfall. Strong breeze to near gale conditions is likely over the localities where Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal #1 is in effect, especially in the coastal and mountainous areas of these localities.

Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal (TCWS) No. 1 is tagged for Surigao del Sur, Davao Oriental, Davao de Oro, and the eastern portion of Agusan del Sur (Prosperidad, San Francisco, Rosario, Bunawan, Trento, Santa Josefa, Veruela).
