1. The Sectoral Unification, Capacity Building and Empowerment (SUCBEM) of the National Task Force to End Local Community Armed Conflict (NTF-ELCAC) shall hold a Two-day Regional Conference for Peace and Development (RCPD) on **May 14, 2021** (previously scheduled on May 24 per memo) and **June 1, 2021** online and face-to-face, respectively.

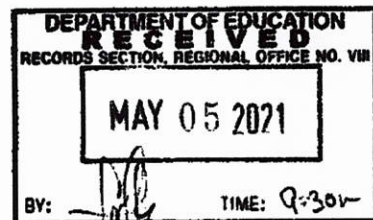
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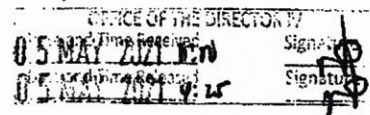

The Sectoral Unification, Capacity Building and Empowerment (SUCBEM) Cluster of the National Task Force to End Local Terrorist Communist Armed Conflict (NTF-ELCAC) is organizing a two-day Regional Conference for Peace and Development (RCPD) in all regions with the following objectives:

1. engage various sectors in a dialogue regarding issues and concerns affecting the sector in the region;
2. discuss agency responses and ways forward in relation to the issues and concerns; and
3. discuss organizing strategies appropriate for each sector.

The first day of the conference will be online and the second will be face to face, with selected participants for the first day attending the second day. The conference schedule is attached.

One of the sectors identified for this conference is the youth sector, composed of children and youth in school (basic and tertiary), and community-based youth. 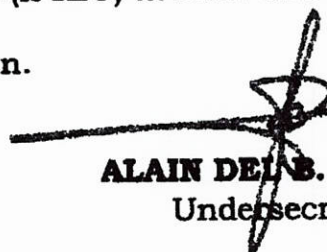
