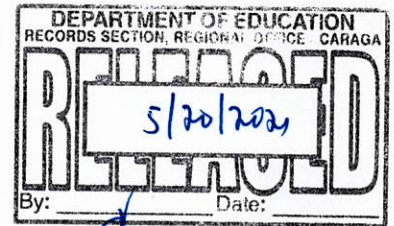

DATE: May 10, 2021

The Basic Education - Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) as prescribed in DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2020 is the Department of Education's major response and commitment in protecting the health, safety, and well-being of learners, teachers, and personnel. It provides guidelines in determining and implementing delivery approaches that are suited to the local context and diversity of learners while adapting to the challenges caused by COVID-19.

The Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) identified the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) in exploratory and mandatory subjects while the curriculum guide for the specializations served as the primary references aside from the SPTVE curriculum.

Despite the DepEd's LCP, the identified MELCs for techvoc-related subjects and specializations were limited. Given this limitation, the implementation of the techvoc curriculum became one of the toughest challenges encountered by the implementing schools.

To elicit feedback on the SPTVE implementation particularly on (i) the different modalities adopted by the school in implementing the SPTVE; (ii) issues and challenges encountered; (iii) actions taken to resolve the issues and challenges; (iv) best practices; and (v) recommendations for the improvement of the program, a virtual focus group discussion (FGD) with CLMD regional and CID division supervisors in charge of techvoc will be conducted on **May 20, 2021** and with school



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heads and teachers from STVEP implementing schools on **May 21, 2021**, respectively, through MS Teams platform.

In this regard, the concerned regions are requested to submit the List of Confirmed Participants (Attachment 1) based on the pre-identified divisions and schools list (Attachment 2) to ma.nayve@deped.gov.ph before May 14, 2021.

The links to registration and virtual meeting will be sent to confirmed participants.

To facilitate access to MS platforms, the participants are likewise requested to provide two (2) email accounts – main and alternate, in their profile.

Their participation in this activity is highly expected.

Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
