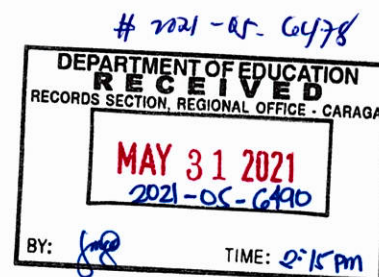

MECHANICS FOR SPOKEN POETRY COMPETITION

MECHANICS/GUIDELINES:

SPOKEN POETRY is a performance art that is word based. It is a writing that is meant to be spoken or delivered with emotions to an audience. It is an oral art that focuses on the aesthetics of word play, rhythm, improvisation, rhymes, intonation and voice inflection.

1. The contest is open to all **Elementary School Pupils in Butuan City Division**.
2. Each participating pupil shall fill-out the online register form here:

3. The spoken poetry must be an original composition. It should be written in **Filipino**.
4. For the safety of the participants, the performance shall be **video recorded** and sent to secretariat along with a **word file of the spoken poetry piece**.
5. Each participant is given a maximum of **2 to 3 minutes to deliver his/her piece**.
6. The piece must be related to the four thematic areas, namely, (1) **Disaster Prevention and Mitigation**; (2) **Disaster Preparedness**; (3) **Disaster Response**; and (4) **Disaster Rehabilitation and Recovery**.
7. Submitted piece shall be an original work of the participant. The participant shall be held accountable for any issues that may question the originality and authenticity of the piece.
8. All entries should be submitted on or before **July 12, 2021** via email:
drmd.focrg@dswd.gov.ph in either "mp4" or "avi" format.
9. All entries will be owned by the organizer/concerned committee once submitted.

THE CONTESTANTS WILL BE JUDGED USING THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

a. Message/ Content- 40%

- The content of the spoken piece is relevant and related to the theme.
- The piece has a powerful and meaningful message to the audience.

b. Delivery and Performance- 30%

- The spoken piece was delivered from the heart.
- Facial expressions, hand and body gestures emphasized the different elements of the performance.
- Audience's attention and interest were captured and sustained throughout the delivery.
- Enunciation is clear. Audience can understand what is being spoken.
- Words are pronounced distinctly and correctly. Does not stutter nor stammer.
- Pronunciation and intonation sound natural.

c. Memorization- 10%

- The piece was effectively recited from memory.
- Freestyle or improvisation was spontaneous even if a word or line was forgotten.

d. Voice Variation and Projection 20%

- Voice is modulated, compelling and phrasing is fluent.
- Spoke loudly and clearly enough for listeners to hear and understand.
- Voice projects confidence and conviction.

PRIZES

There will be three (3) winners, 3rd, 2nd and 1st/champion, who will be given cash prizes plus plaque/token and to be announced during the Culmination Activity on July 30, 2021:

1st Place/Champion – PhP 2,500 + Plaque + Certificate

2nd Place – PhP 2,000 + Plaque + Certificate

3rd Place – PhP 1,500 + Plaque + Certificate

LOGO-MAKING CONTEST

To date, the Regional Disaster Response Committee (RDRC) in Caraga do not have their own logo. The purpose of this activity is to come up with such logo that will reflect the elements that describe RDRC.

MECHANICS:

1. The contest is open to **High School – Senior High School Students** in Butuan City Division.
2. Logo should be digital/graphic designed, original and may be a pictorial mark logo, abstract mark logo, emblem logo or a combination mark logo
3. Entries should be in digitized format ("**png**" and "**psd**" or "**ai**") with a resolution of 300 dpi with the following attachment: Rationale of the logo and its details (not exceeding 500 words)
4. All submitted work must be the original work of the entrant(s) and must not be include, be based on, or deprived from any pre-existing or third-party designs, trademarks, or copyrighted images. The participant shall be held accountable for any issues that may question the originality and authenticity of the design.
5. Each student can only submit 1 logo entry for the duration of the contest.

7. All entries should be submitted on or before **July 12, 2021** via email: drmd.focrg@dswd.gov.ph in both "png", and "psd" or "ai" formats.
8. All logo entries will be owned by the organizer/concerned committee once submitted.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING:

- Originality and Distinctiveness of entry- **30 %**
- Relevance to the Functions of the Committees- **50%**
- Quality and Design (PNG version) - **20%**

WINNERS

- There will be three (3) winners, 3rd, 2nd and 1st/champion, who will be given cash prizes plus plaque/token and to be announced during the Culmination Activity on July 30, 2021:
1st Place/Champion – PhP 3,500 + Plaque + Certificate
2nd Place – PhP 2,500 + Plaque + Certificate
3rd Place – PhP 1,500 + Plaque + Certificate
- Entry that is declared 1st place/champion in each category will officially become the logo of the committee in the region.
