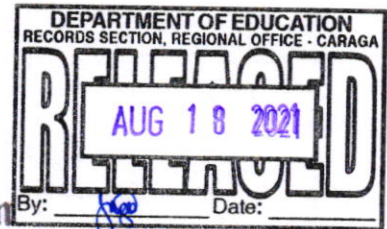

REGIONAL IMPLEMENTATION OF BRIGADA PABASA SA CARAGA

- Pursuant to the Memorandum OU-LAPP No. 0-267, s.2021 re Guidelines On The Utilization of Program Support Funds For Building Partnership and Linkages Program (Bplp) For Fiscal Year 2021, Annex A on the implementation of *The Brigada Pagbasa Program*, this office shall intensify the implementation of the said activity to improve the literacy and reading skills of the Caraganon learners.
- Brigada Pagbasa is one of the Brigada Eskwela mandated patnership activities. This is an after school reading program that envisions to bring together the different stakeholders across all sectors and agencies to form partnership and collaboration to help all learners be functional readers.
- This project dubbed as "Brigada Sa Pagbasa sa Caraga" is a call for Brigada Pagbasa Volunteers for improving the literacy skills of the Caraganons for the School Year 2021-2022.
- The activity aims to:
 - improve the literacy skills of learners;
 - increase awareness on literacy intruction; and,
 - forge strong partnership among stakeholders.
- All Schools Division Offices are enjoined to support the activities of the said program.
- The Bridaga sa Pagbasa sa Caraga Volunteers may opt to be a Volunteer Reader, Volunteer Tutor, Volunteer Book donors and Volunteer Support. Attached herewith is the Brigada Pagbasa Activities.

Volunteer	Roles and Responsibilities
Volunteer readers	These are partners who shall serve as book reader to the recipient child/ children in the community. They must be residing within the community where their recipients reside to abide the health protocol set by the IATF.
Volunteer tutors	These are partners who will tutor a child/ children within their community for 1-2 hours everyday. They shall volunteer to tutor a child/children how to read. They must be residing within the community where their recipients reside to abide the health protocol set by the IATF.



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Volunteer donors	These are interested individuals or organization who are willing to donate reading materials and share other learning resources. They may come from all sectors and agencies public and private. The donation shall be given to their chosen school/ recipients.
Volunteer support	These are interested individuals and organizations who are willing to support the volunteer readers, tutor and tutee by providing refreshments, schools supplies and and other resources during the conduct of the activity.

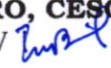
7. Volunteer teacher-applicants may also serve as reading teachers or tutors and shall be given certificates for teaching experience corresponding to the number of hours/ days they have rendered their services.

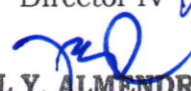
