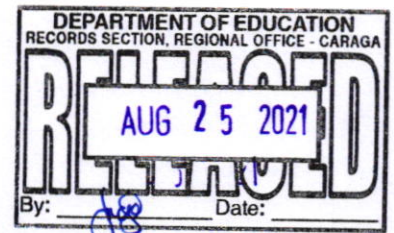

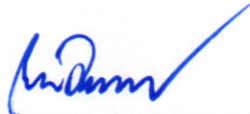

WinS Program Video Presentation Guidelines

1. Guide questions pertaining to the implementation of WinS program in the time of COVID-19 pandemic to be answered by the narrator and/or interviewee (preferably, the School Head and/or School WinS Coordinator/Focal) in the video presentation of each SDOs are as follows:
 - a. Challenges schools encountered given the ongoing pandemic and how they overcome/rise above them; and/or
 - b. Best practices/innovations schools have adopted to respond to the challenges brought about by the pandemic;
2. The duration of the video presentation must be 2-3 minutes (must not exceed 3 minutes);
3. The following procedures are recommended when recording a video:
 - a. Subject must be positioned at the center of the frame;
 - b. Medium Shot (from the top of their head to roughly their waist) is recommended;
 - c. Give at least an inch for the head room of the subject;
 - d. Set audio recording to stereo;
 - e. Choose a good background, face the window instead and use it as a source of light;
 - f. Illuminate your face using a ring light or any source of light;
4. Video format should be MP4 with 1080p or 720p resolution;
5. Recommended minimum specifications for videos:
 - a. File Format: MP4
 - b. Dimensions: 1920px x 1080px (16:9)
 - c. Orientation; Landscape
 - d. Frame Rate: 30fps
