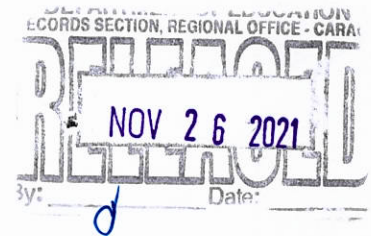

Event Rules and Mechanics - Poster Making Contest is a virtual on-the-spot competition. Further instructions shall be given during the orientation. - One (1) student-participant per region is allowed. - Participants are given 3 hours to finish their outputs. - Output must be submitted 15 MINUTES after the competition via cpu@deped.gov.ph - File name format should follow POSTER_REGION_#. (POSTER_REGION_I) - Student-participant may be accompanied by one coach. However, coaches are only allowed to assist the student during the setting up of materials on the day of the competition.		



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- g. Student-participant may be accompanied by one coach. However, coaches are only allowed to assist the student during the setting up of materials on the day of the competition.
- h. Participants shall provide ½ size illustration board and must use the white background in vertical background.
- i. The medium for visual artistry shall only be limited to oil pastel and shall be provided by the contestant.
- j. Participants are not allowed to bring pictures or images for reference of their entries.
- k. The theme of the poster will be given before the contest proper.
- l. Finished outputs should not contain label or name that may identify the region.
- m. The poster must be original. If the submitted poster is found to have been plagiarized, it will be disqualified from the competition.
- n. The contestants and coaches of the Top 5 winning posters will receive a Certificate of Recognition.
- o. The winners will be notified through email, phone call, and official letter.
- p. CPU-DepEd staff and their relatives up to the third degree of consanguinity or affinity are not eligible to join.
- q. All entries shall be considered property of the CPU-DepEd and may be used by the Unit for publication and any other legal purpose.
- r. Upon joining the contest, student contestants who are over 18 years of age, or their parents, guardians, or caregivers, if they are minors, consent to the use of their personal information as included in the outputs that they will submit for purposes of publication if they be declared as winners, consistent with the provision of the Data Privacy Act.

Event Rules and Mechanics - Essay Writing Contest is a virtual on-the-spot competition. Further instructions shall be given during the orientation. - One (1) student-participant per region is allowed. - Participants are given 2 hours to finish their outputs. - Output must be submitted right after the competition via cpu@deped.gov.ph - The essay should have a title. - Participants shall use A4 size bond paper/s. - Entries should be in Filipino, encoded, double-spaced, with a minimum of 1,500 words and maximum of 3,000 words. - Finished outputs should not contain label or name that may identify the region. - The essay must be original. If the submitted essay is found to have been plagiarized, it will be disqualified from the competition.		



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- j. Entries must be submitted right after the competition via cpu@deped.gov.ph
- k. File name format should follow **ESSAY_REGION_#. (ESSAY_REGION_I)**

Event Rules and Mechanics - The video essay contest is a short video competition. Further instructions shall be given during the orientation. - One (1) student-participant per region is allowed. - The video essay should run for a minimum length of 5 minutes and maximum length of 8 minutes. - The video essay should have a title. - The content of the video essay must be anchored on the theme “<i>New Normal na Walang Iwanan: Karapatan ng Bawat Bata Ating Tutukan!</i>” - Videos should be encoded on commonly known video file compressions/formats such as .mp4, .avi, and .mkv.		



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- f. Finished outputs should not contain label or name that may identify the region.
- g. Entries must be submitted to cpu@deped.gov.ph by December 17, 2021, using the Coaches' official DepEd email address.
- h. A Google Drive link may also be used to submit large file formats. In the event that the link is broken/defective or not accessible, submitted entry will no longer be included in the competition.
- i. File name format should follow **VIDEOESSAY_REGION_#**.
