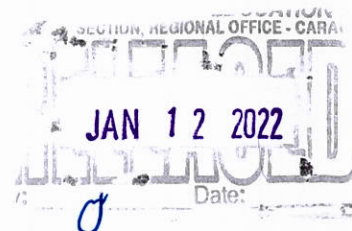

SUBJECT : **Focus Group Discussion on Initial Gains and Challenges on the Learning Component of the Pilot Implementation of Limited Face-to-Face Classes**

DATE : 4 January 2022

The Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) is mandated to support the field offices and schools in the delivery of basic education services for learners in different learning delivery modalities. With the issuance of Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01, s. 2021, *Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of Limited Face-to-Face Learning Modality*, the Department emphasizes the mechanisms and standards on the resumption of face-to-face classes. In order to ensure that the learning component of limited face-to-face classes are properly implemented and to offer mechanisms for improvement, as may be needed, the BLD enjoins the **select education program supervisors, school heads and teachers** to attend the focus group discussion (FGD) on **January 14, 2022, from 8:30 am - 12 pm via Zoom**.

The FGD aims to discuss the initial gains and challenges encountered by the pilot implementers of face-to-face classes. Specifically, it aims to ensure that:

- there is a logical continuity of the teaching-learning process in-school and off-school;
- Learning Progress Checklist and other tools and types of formative assessments are properly developed and administered to learners;
- learning tasks are constructed towards the attainment of the Most Essential Learning Competencies and promote socio-emotional learning; and,
- other concerns on the teaching and learning component are raised to eliminate its possibility of occurrence in the expansion of school reopening and reduce its negative impact.

Each region must send seven (7) participants that include the following:

- one (1) regional EPS
- one (1) division EPS
- one (1) elementary school head
- one (1) SHS school head
- one (1) kindergarten teacher
- one (1) Grade 1 to 3 teacher
- one (1) SHS teacher

Participants are advised to use their laptop and must have access to strong internet connection during the FGD to be able to actively participate in the discussion.
