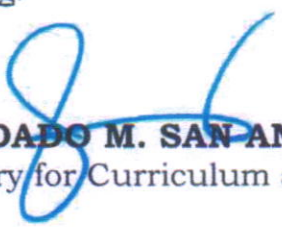
2022 DR. GOH KENG SWEE (GKS) SCHOLARSHIP

The **Association of Banks in Singapore (ABS)**, as conveyed by the **Embassy of the Republic of Singapore**, announces the application for the **2022 Dr. Goh Keng Swee (GKS) Scholarship**. The Dr. GKS Scholarship was set up by the financial community in Singapore in honor of the former Deputy Prime Minister, who fostered Singapore's economic development and growth as a reputable international financial center. The 2022 Dr. GKS Scholarship application commenced on **November 15, 2021 and will end on March 31, 2022**.

The Dr. GKS Scholarship is open to students who are citizens/passport holders of Brunei, Cambodia, Hong Kong SAR, India, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Philippines, PRC, Taiwan, Vietnam, Thailand, Laos and Myanmar. Applicants should:

- ensure that the necessary university admission requirements are met (inclusive of sitting for any required university entrance examinations);
- concurrently apply for admission to NUS, NTU, SMU or SUTD. Most courses (except for specialized courses like Medicine) will be considered. Applicants should adhere to the university's admission deadlines and guidelines;
- demonstrate leadership qualities and possess good academic and co-curricular activities (CCA) achievements; and
- have taken the SAT or made arrangement to take the SAT.

DR GOH KENG SWEE (GKS) SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Applicants should:

- (a) Be citizens/passport holders of the 15 Asia Pacific territories¹;
- (b) Ensure that the necessary university admission requirements are met (inclusive of sitting for any required university entrance examinations);
- (c) Concurrently apply for admission to Singapore's Institute of Higher Learning - National University of Singapore (NUS), Nanyang Technological University (NTU), Singapore Management University (SMU) or Singapore University of Technology and Design (SUTD) and adhere to the university's admission deadlines and guidelines;
- (d) Possess strong leadership qualities, good academic and co-curricular activities (CCA) achievements; and
- (e) Have taken the SAT or made arrangement to take the SAT (results* must be submitted by 31 March 2022).

**The SAT is optional for those who have a confirmed placement at NUS, NTU, SMU or SUTD.*

DURATION & TERMS OF AWARD

The scholarship will support a maximum of 4 years of undergraduate study (may include Honours). It provides the following:

- (a) Tuition and other compulsory fees;
- (b) Airfare (to Singapore and return to home country upon completion of study);
- (c) Annual maintenance allowance of SGD6500;
- (d) Hostel allowance based on institution of study; and
- (e) Settling-in allowance (one-off expense) of SGD200 upon arrival in Singapore.

The scholarship award will be reviewed annually and is subject to satisfactory performance and academic results.
