Subject : SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED SITES FOR ALTERNATIVE LEARNING
SYSTEM COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER (CLC)

Date : March 22, 2022

Section 13 of Republic Act 11510¹, also known as the Alternative Learning System Act, provides for an ALS Community Learning Center, specifically:

The DepEd or the LGU or both shall provide at least one (1) ALS CLC in every municipality and city throughout the country to facilitate a learning environment for the full implementation of the ALS K to 12 BEC and other ALS programs. Priority should be given to areas where there is limited access to formal basic education or higher concentration of out-of-school children in special cases, or adults lacking basic literacy skills or have dropped out of formal school, or both.

In compliance with the said provision of the ALS Act, this Office and the Bureau of Alternative Education are proposing for the construction of a school-based ALS CLC. As agreed in the 16th National ALS Consultative Conference, we are requesting from the Regional Office through the Regional ALS Focal Person to identify/ propose a site, **either within a public elementary or secondary school**, where the ALS CLC will be constructed.
