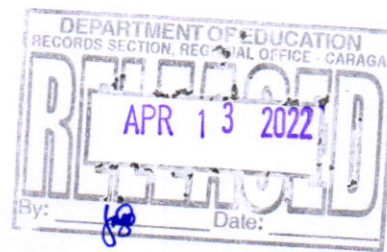

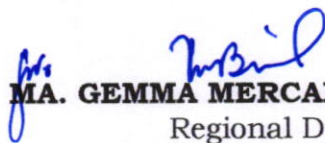

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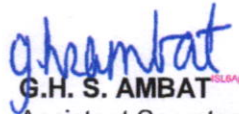

PROGRAMME FOR ALS TEACHERS - BATCH 2 TO 9

DATE : April 5, 2022

The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) in partnership with UNICEF-Philippines, through the Center for Integrated STEM Education in the Philippines (CISTEM), will conduct the **Training on the STEM Up to Step Up Programme for ALS Teachers - Batch 2 to 9**. It is a two-year programme that aims to boost the growth mindset and employability of our ALS learners through integrated STEM Education. It involves ALS module and resource enhancement, capacity-building of teachers and building a supportive ecosystem with community stakeholders to facilitate the integration and application of STEM-oriented pedagogies and socio-emotional learning in the ALS K-12 Basic Education Curriculum.

The training workshop for Batch 1 was conducted last February 14-18, 2022. **Batch 2 to 9**, which will start in **April of 2022**, will be a 2-week workshop consisting of five (5) synchronous sessions through Zoom, and asynchronous sessions using the DepEd PD LMS platform. Coaching sessions will also be scheduled to guide the participants with their expected outputs.

In this connection, may we request that all selected participants be excused from all other activities on the duration of their workshop schedule.

In line with the new normal, there will be a **One (1)-Day Pilot Face-to-Face Workshop for Batch 2** in one of the synchronous sessions on **April 27, 2022**, to be attended by the participants from **NCR**. The link and other instructions related to the activity will be sent to the respective email of the participants.
