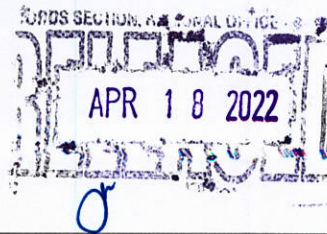

WRITESHOP ON REVISING THE REHABILITATION AND RECOVERY PLANS
FOR TYPHOON ODETTE DAMAGED SCHOOLS-CUM-ORIENTATION
ON UPDATED AND DETAILED RADAR TOOLS FOR
DRRM COORDINATORS

1. Per OUA Memo No. 00-0322-0204 issued by the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration, all Regional Offices shall submit a revised Rehabilitation and Recovery Plan (RRP) for Typhoon Odette damaged schools to their respective NDRRMC, NEDA, and other agencies where the initial RRP were submitted.
2. The revision of the plans was due to OUA Memo No. 00-0222-0113 entitled, "Prioritization on the Utilization of 2022 QRF", where all damaged schools with Program of Works (POWs) that were not included in the 2022 QRF shall be integrated in the list of unfunded repair and new construction, specifying the source of fund as DepEd QRF, NDRRM Fund, or from external partners.
3. Due to the urgent need to revise the plan, this office, thru the DRRM Program, shall immediately conduct the **Writeshop on Revising the Rehabilitation and Recovery Plans (RRPs) of the Typhoon Odette-heavily affected SDOs on April 26-28, 2022**, in Siargao Island Division to be participated by all Twelve (12) Division DRRM Coordinators.
4. The three-day writeshop shall also include the following-activities:
 - Orientation and technical sharing on the updated/detailed RADaR Tools used in the Typhoon Odette monitoring and reporting system with actual field immersion of the division DRRM Coordinators;
 - Drafting of the Guidelines on the Creation of the Regional and Division Quick Response and Rehabilitation Teams (QRRTs) in consideration of the challenges experienced by the Divisions;
 - Discussion on adopting the Twinning System at the Regional level as one response initiative to provide augmentation of non-affected SDOs to affected SDOs (particularly on the crafting of Post Disaster Needs Assessment,

RADaRs, and the operation of OPCEN) for Typhoon and Super typhoon-level or > 6.0 magnitude Earthquake, and;

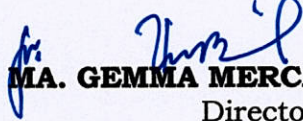
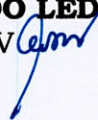
- Provision of psychological support to fellow Division and School DRRM Coordinators.

5. Participants shall be provided with meals/snacks and board/lodging for the entire duration. Coordinators of the SDOs Agusan del Norte, Cabadbaran City, Dinagat, Siargao, Surigao City, and Surigao del Norte are requested to prepare their data on Typhoon Odette damages in schools to include the detailed RADaRs, RRP, QRF prioritized schools, PDNAs, and other relevant documents.

6. Participants are expected to arrive in Siargao Island on Tuesday, April 26, 2022, and board the earliest scheduled vessel at 6:00am. The SDO Siargao shall provide vehicle to pick-up the participants at the seaport.

7. Venue of the writeshop shall be informed to the participants within the week via email or thru DRRM Coordinators' official chat group. Reimbursement of travel expenses, per diems and other expenses incurred shall be charged against FY 2022 DRRM Program Support Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

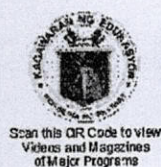
Subject: PROCUREMENT AND DOWNLOADING OF PROJECTS UNDER
CY 2022 QUICK RESPONSE FUND (QRF) AND LIST OF
SCHOOLS FOR THE NATIONAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION
AND MANAGEMENT FUND (NDRRMF)

This is in reference to OUA MEMO 00-0222-0113 "PRIORITIZATION ON THE UTILIZATION OF 2022 QRF" dated 17 February 2022. Attached herewith is the summary of schools that will be allocated with funds for repair and reconstruction under the 2022 QRF, based on the rankings submitted to the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) and Education Facilities Division (EFD).

Schools with Program of Works (POWs) that were not included in the 2022 QRF will be integrated into the list of unfunded repair and new construction and will be requested allocation from NDRRMF of the National Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC).

Regions and divisions with schools included in the QRF and NDRRMF are directed to revise their respective Rehabilitation and Recovery Plan (RRP), indicating the cost of repair and/or new construction, and specifying the fund source as DepEd QRF, NDRRM Fund, or the name of their external partners.

All concerned Regional Offices must submit their revisions to their respective Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (RDRRMC), the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA), and all other agencies where the initial RRP were submitted, copy furnishing DRRMS and EFD. These submissions will be consolidated by the DRRMS for the creation of Comprehensive Rehabilitation and Recovery Plan (CRRP). The DRRMS will request the allocation of funds under the NDRRMF using the CRRP.

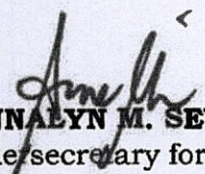

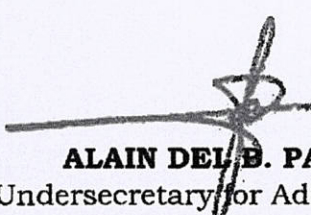
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For the priority schools included in Annex A of this memorandum, the respective Division Offices are hereby directed to proceed with the procurement short of awarding. As indicated in a DepEd Advisory dated 23 February 2022 "RE: CONDUCT OF PROCUREMENT ACTIVITIES DURING ELECTION PERIOD" and pursuant to the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) Circular No. 20-2021 dated 2 December 2021, "*Procuring Entities (PEs) are allowed to proceed with the commencement and completion of procurement activities during the election period.*" "*However, during the election ban period from March 25 to May 8 procuring entities are prohibited from issuing a Notice of Award (NOA) for "Public works-related projects such as DepEd's new construction, repair, Gabaldon, electrification, and health facilities programs" (per section 3.2 of GPPB Circular No. 03-2021). The issuance of NOA for these projects may resume after the election ban period.*"

The sub-SARO will be issued based on the amount reflected in the Resolution to Award (RTA). Upon perfection of the RTA, the Implementing Units (IUs) shall submit the document to EFD as reference for the issuance of sub-SARO. Copies of the RTAs shall be sent to as.efd@deped.gov.ph before processing the sub-SARO.

Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are directed.
