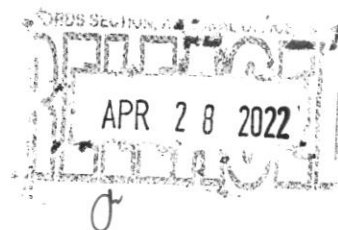

1.  - c. establish a stronger linkage between the DepEd central and field offices in implementing and delivery of the ALS programs.

- ensure that members of the Speakers Bureau are available in each region/division to inform, update and answer queries from the Department of Education, partners, and stakeholders; and
- establish a stronger linkage between the DepEd central and field offices in implementing and delivery of the ALS programs.

Teaching and non-teaching personnel attending the said workshop will be entitled to service credits pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 67, series 2021 on the Amendment to DepEd Memorandum No.65, s. 2021 (Clarificatory Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers for School Year 2021-2021 In Light of the Covid-19 Pandemic) and per CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 entitled Non-Mandatory Remuneration for Overtime Services, whichever is appropriate and applicable.
