BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

• **Rationale**

The pursuit of excellence is an integral goal of the education system. Consequently, qualitative, and relevant educational programs and services for the gifted are basic aspects of that effort. The aims of education for the gifted are as follows (Sutaria. 1983):

- assist each gifted and talented child to develop his intellectual abilities and talents in the arts and sciences, mathematics, history or in any creative and productive endeavor through varied and enriched activities.

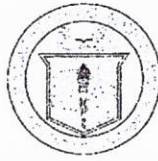
- stimulate social situations in which each gifted child undergoes experiences that develop knowledge, skills, and attitudes contributory to responsible leadership.

- help the gifted child become a morally upright and socially competent citizen who is sensitive to the needs and rights of his fellowmen.

- provide activities which train the gifted child to become scientifically minded and help him to develop to the limits of his potential.¹

The Department of Education (DepEd) envisions to provide all learners opportunities to learn, grow and realize their full potential and become productive members of the society. However, existing DepEd policies, orders, and other related issuances for Gifted and Talented Program had resulted to different interpretations and implementations in the field. The DepEd hereby formulates policy guidelines for the gifted and talented learners to harmonize and facilitate common understanding in providing education for children who possess a wide range of cognition, artistry, creativity, and leadership skills. It will ensure that every gifted and talented learner is accommodated and given opportunity anchored in the K-12 program

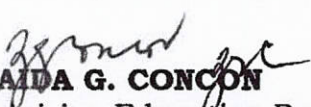

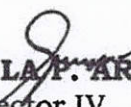
