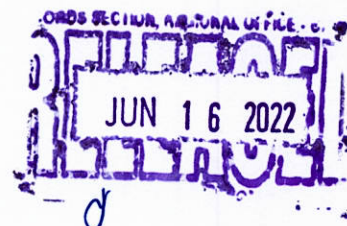

**MASS TRAINING OF ALS TEACHERS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
ALS ACT AND ITS IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR)**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum OM-OAGA-2022-059 regarding the National Training of Regional Core of Trainers for ALS Act and its IRR, the Department of Education Caraga Region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct the Mass Training of ALS Teachers In the Implementation of the ALS ACT and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) on July 25-26, 2022-Batch 1 and July 28-29, 2022-Batch 2 in F2F modality (inclusive of travel) and the venue will be announced later.
2. The training aims the participants to:
 - a. update and make all ALS implementers knowledgeable about then provisions of R.A. 11510, also known as the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR);
 - b. ensure that all ALS implementers of the 12 SDOs are equipped, ready to inform, update and answer queries from the Department of Education, partners, and stakeholders ; and
 - c. establish a stronger linkage between the DepEd central and field offices in implementing and delivery of the ALS programs.
