**National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) 2023
DRRM-CCA Video-Making Contest 2023**

I. Mechanics

- 1.1 The DRRM-CCA Video-Making Contest 2023 is open to all public schools in the region (Junior and Senior High Schools) who are officially enrolled for School Year 2022-2023;
- 1.2 There shall be only **ONE (1)** entry per school division. Thus, a total of 12 entries are expected to participate in the contest;
- 1.3 The video entry must be an **ORIGINAL** piece. The entry **must not have been used** in any video-making competitions;
- 1.4 The DRRM-CCA video must be creatively shot and will revolve around and best relate to this year's NDRM theme. No use of foul, mean, offensive, or rude words;
- 1.5 The video must run from a minimum of three (3) minutes to a maximum of five (5) minutes. A minute of extension shall incur an automatic deduction of one (1) point from the total garnered score;
- 1.6 The following shall be submitted to OCD Caraga Regional Office through e-mail at civildefensecaraga@gmail.com on or before July 22, 2023:
 - DRRM-CCA Video entry
 - Script of the video
 - List of students and coaches; and
 - Scanned copy of the Official Endorsement by the School Division Office (duly signed by the Schools Division Superintendent)
- 1.7 All DRRM-CCA video entries will become the property of the Caraga RDRRMC and will be used for advocacy and awareness activities;
- 1.8 The judges will only declare three (3) winners- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd, and five (5) consolation entries; and
- 1.9 The decision of the board of judges is **FINAL, IRREVOCABLE, and NON-APPEALABLE.**

II. Criteria

Criteria	Percentage
1) Composition (originality, appealing, cinematography, and audio quality)	50 %
2) Coherence/Relevance to the NDRM 2022 Theme	30 %
3) Appeal or impact	20 %
Total	100 %

III. Declaration of Winners, Awarding, and Prizes

3.1 The winners will be declared and awarded during the NDRM Culmination Activity on July 28, 2023;

3.2 The prizes are as follows:

3 rd Place Winner	Php 7,500.00	Bronze Plaque

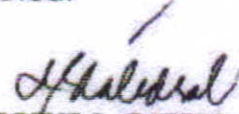

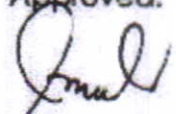
