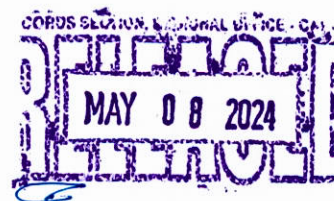

REGIONAL TRAINING OF TEACHERS FOR ALTERNATIVE LEARNING
SYSTEM (ALS) ASSESSMENT

1. In accordance with DepEd Memorandum DM-CT-2023-285, which pertains to the National Training of Trainers on Capability Building on Alternative Learning System (ALS) Assessment, the Department of Education Caraga Region, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct the Regional Training of Teachers for Alternative Learning System (ALS) Assessment. The event is scheduled to take place from May 22-24, 2024, at the VCDU Prince Inc. located in Purok 2 Elloso St. Imadejas, Butuan City.
2. The primary objectives of this training are as follows:
 - a. Develop proficiency among ALS teachers in designing diverse assessment tools customized to address the unique needs of ALS learners;
 - b. Enhance skills in interpreting assessment results to inform instructional strategies and interventions; and
 - c. Improve ability to implement fair and inclusive assessment practices that cater to the diverse needs and backgrounds of ALS learners.
3. Participants expected to attend this activity include Division ALS Focal Persons, EPSAs, ALS Teachers, School Heads, trainers, BJMP Facilitators, and Program Management Team from the 12 Schools Division Offices.
