1. The Regional Research Congress 2018 will be conducted on December 7, 2018 at LMX, Butuan City.
2. The theme for this year's Congress embeds on "**TRANSFORMING BASIC EDUCATION LANDSCAPE**" which will be participated by the researchers.
3. The Congress aims to:
 - present action and basic researches conducted by teaching and non-teaching personnel through oral research presentation or research poster;
 - recognize and award Best Oral Research Presentation, and Best Research Poster;
 - disseminate research findings, results, conclusions and recommendations during the parallel sessions;
 - gain insights on how the participants can espouse/adopt laudable action and basic researches.
4. Participants from the schools division offices include the SDS and ASDS, Chief CID, Chief SGOD and SEPS for Research, and researchers.
5. Guidelines for the presentation mechanics, the criteria, the list of committees/members and researchers are indicated in the attached enclosure no. 1-4 for easy reference.
6. There will be one (1) contestant for the Best Oral Research Presentation and Best Research Poster per division and the contestant shall be within the identified participants as indicated in the attached enclosure.
7. There will be no registration fee required. Participants will be served with lunch and snacks.
8. Travel and other related expenses of the participants from the schools divisions shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

1. The Oral and Poster Presenters shall be guided by the following mechanics of Presentation:

A. Oral Presentation

- i. Presentation shall last for 15-20 minutes with 10 minutes for open forum. The moderator will inform the presenter to start the presentation, a flashcard "START" will be raised and time count will start the moment the presenter starts talking. On the 10th minute, a flashcard "STOP" will be raised by the time-keeper and the moderator will advise the presenter to end the presentation. The presenter MAY NO LONGER proceed with the presentation after the moderator's advise to stop.
- ii. Each of the judges will be allowed to give constructive comments and ask only one question from the presenters. The moderator will facilitate the flow of this portion of the presentation to contain all the questions and answers within 10 minutes.
- iii. Oral presentations will be judged using the criteria. (Enclosure no. 2)
- iv. Oral Presenters must wear a corporate attire.
- v. The power point presentation should follow the following format.
 - a. Slide 1 - Title and Author/s
 - b. Slide2 - Rationale
 - c. Slide 3 and 4 - Methodology
 - d. Slide 5 - Findings
 - e. Slide 6 - Conclusions
 - g. Slide 7 - Recommendations

B. Interactive Poster Presentation

- i. Each presenter will be given 3-5 minutes to discuss the research before participants will interact with other participants.
- ii. Presenter is advised to use vertical {portrait} layout of 48 x 36-inch size. It shall be displayed in the designated area.
- iii. Poster should include the Abstract, Introduction, Research Questions, Research Design, Results and Discussions, Conclusions and References.
- iv. Suggested font sizes: Title, 80-90 points; Authors, 50-60 points; Headings, 40 - 50 points; Text, 30- 40 points.
- v. Letters and illustrations should be clear and readable even at a distance of 4 feet from the poster.
- vi. Posters should be mounted before the opening ceremonies of the 2019 Caraga Regional Research Congress. All posters should be displayed throughout the congress with corresponding outputs to showcase.
- Vii. The presenter should be in his/her assigned poster board from 10:00-12:00 AM on December 7, 2018. Judges will be allowed to give comments and ask questions from the presenter.

2. Awards and Prizes

- i. A cash prize awaits the first placer. There is a cash award for the best oral research presenter and best research poster.

3. The decision of the judges will be final.

A. CRITERIA FOR ASSESSING ORAL RESEARCH PRESENTATION (40 points)

1. Organization of contents (10 points)

- Were presentation contents organized in a manner that is easy to follow?
- Is the presentation able to stimulate audience interest?

2. Answers to questions (20 points)

- Were judges' questions answered in a clear and concise manner?

3. Delivery (20 points)

- Did the presenter's voice modulation, grooming, poise and diction contribute to the success of the presentation?

B. JUDGING CRITERIA FOR ASSESSING RESEARCH POSTERS (100 points)

1. Audience Awareness (15 points)

- Does the poster convey the research findings in a manner that a non-subject specialist will understand?
- Is the poster able to stimulate the audience interest?

2. Content (30 points)

- Researcher is able to convey reasons of his interest in the research topic.
- Clear in presenting the research objectives.
- Clear and appropriate methods.
- Results presented clearly and in a concise manner.
- Results supporting the conclusion(s) made.
- Conclusion drawn will surely help improve existing practice.

3. Visual Design (25 points)

- Appropriate use of color and artistic design?
- Texts and illustrations clear even at 4 feet distance?

- Appropriate use of texts, figures, pictures, graphs and illustrations in the poster?
- All elements in the poster come together to attract readers' interest?

4. Text and Grammar (15 points)

- Text concise and easy to read.
- Neither misspelled texts nor grammatical errors.

5. Poster Presentation Skills (15 points)

- Judges' questions were answered in a clear and concise manner.
- Presenter showed mastery of his research work.
