PARTICIPATION OF SELECT SCHOOLS IN KHAN ACADEMY ACTIVITIES FOR PILOT IMPLEMENTATION YEAR 2

1. In reference to Memorandum DM-CT-2024-358, the Department of Education (DepEd) and Khan Academy Philippines Inc. (KA PH) have partnered to implement programs in select schools aimed at improving educational outcomes. This initiative aligns with DepEd's vision of strengthening foundational literacy and numeracy skills, revitalizing Reading, Science, and Math programs, and supporting both teachers and learners with technology to optimize digital and remote learning benefits.

2. On July 22, 2024, DepEd Caraga, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), issued Regional Memorandum No. 0736, s. 2024, inviting schools to join the Khan Academy Pilot Program in MATATAG-Aligned Mathematics for Grades 1, 4, 5, and 7. Schools submitted Letters of Intent and were required to meet specific criteria, such as stable internet connectivity and a 1:1 device-to-student ratio. Twelve schools qualified through the initial screening process and will join Batch 2 pilot implementers of this technology-driven initiative. The list of schools from Caraga can be found below:

4. For proper facilitation of the activities, please be reminded of the following:

4.1. On school verification:

KA PH liaison officers will visit each school on the list to validate if the schools have met the technological requirements as well as establish rapport with the personnel from the ROs, the SDOs, and school heads. SDO personnel (Math EPS, PSDS and/or Division IT Officer) are requested to accompany the verification team. Schools need not prepare anything such as programs, leis, food, etc. KA PH is expected to stay 20- 30 minutes at each school, during which they will do the following:

• Strong internet connectivity (at least 100 Mbps) • 1 device per student user (in computer lab or wherever they will do Khan) • Eagerness of administrators and teachers to implement Khan	• Grade level and number of sections that will join the pilot (Choices: Grades 1, 4, 5, and 7) • Number of teachers for training	• Principal or Asst. Principal or Grade level head • School ICT focal person

Note: The devices (PCs, laptops, tablets, etc.) in the computer lab should be turned on during the day of the visit so that when the verification team arrives, they can easily check the internet speed.

4.2. After the school verification, Principal of each school that passed the verification must complete the Expression of Interest Form and the Confirmation of Terms of Use for the Khan Academy Philippines, which can be accessed at this link: www.bit.ly/KAPH-Y2-EOI. The deadline of submission is **5:00 p.m. on October 11, 2024.**

4.3. Teacher-implementers who will attend **the face-to-face training** need to pre-register at this link: www.bit.ly/khans2b2. The deadline for registration is **5:00 p.m. on October 15, 2024.**

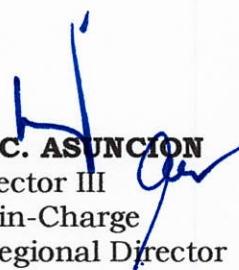
For the face-to-face training of teacher-implementers, KA PH requests a venue within the indicated SDOs/ROs that can accommodate at least 150 pax of teachers and has a strong internet connection. Khan Academy Philippines will provide training kits, morning and afternoon snacks, and lunch. Participants are advised to bring their own device (preferably a laptop) and a backup internet connection.

Teachers should also bring their class list (preferably in digital format), because they will roster the students in their Khan accounts.

4.4. Online training on Khan Academy District
