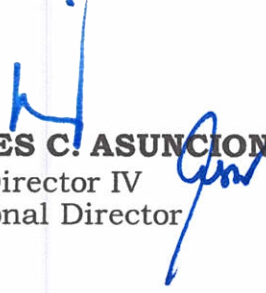
DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOOL SUPPLIES TO PDL, DRUG VICTIMS, CHILDREN IN CONFLICT WITH THE LAW (CICL), AND FORMER REBEL RETURNEES (FRR) ALS LEARNERS

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Caraga Region, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division – Alternative Learning System (CLMD-ALS), will spearhead the **Pathways to Learning: School Supplies Drive for PDL, Drug Victims, CICL, and Former Rebel Returnees ALS Learners**. This initiative seeks to promote inclusivity and strengthen the educational engagement of marginalized learners enrolled in the Alternative Learning System (ALS).
2. The activity aims to provide school supplies to Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDL), drug victims, Children in Conflict with the Law (CICL), and Former Rebel Returnees who are currently enrolled in ALS. It aligns with the principles of inclusive education enshrined in DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2019.
3. The distribution of school supplies is scheduled on June 20, 2025 (Friday), 9:30 a.m. at the Butuan City Jail – Male Dorm Covered Court, Libertad, Butuan City. The event will be attended by the Division ALS Focal Persons, jail representatives, and PDL-ALS learners of Butuan City Jail.
4. All concerned are enjoined to extend full support to ensure the smooth conduct of this activity. Division ALS Focal Persons and identified participants must coordinate with relevant partner agencies and secure the necessary Travel Authorities in compliance with existing DepEd policies and guidelines.
5. Travel expenses shall be charged against the Division ALS PSF, subject to standard accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

**POLICY GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ENHANCED
ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM 2.0**

In compliance to the mandate of Republic Act No. 10533 entitled **Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013** and the 10-point agenda of this administration, the Department of Education (DepEd) issues the enclosed **Guidelines on the Implementation of Enhanced Alternative Learning System (ALS) 2.0** on the 2019 ALS K to 12 Curriculum.
