Prevention and control measures include placing travel limitations and restrictions and guidelines for DepEd Regional/Division Activities. The Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) issued Resolution No. 60-A, dated July 30, 2020, that placed all the provinces in Caraga Region under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) effective August 1, 2020 until August 15, 2020.
