Selection of Teachers for the 2019 Korea-Philippines Teacher Exchange Program (KPTEP)

TO: SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS

This Region

1. The field is hereby informed of the invitation and selection of Filipino Teachers for 2019 Korea-Philippines Teacher Exchange Program (KPTEP).
2. Fourteen (14) Filipino Teachers shall be selected from among applicants and shall be deployed to selected Korean Schools from April 2, 2019 to June 28, 2019 (89 days).
3. During the program, the select 14 Filipino teachers shall:
 - a. design and conduct lessons on intercultural understanding and curriculum related to the subjects in collaboration with their mentor teachers;
 - b. introduce Filipino culture to Korean students and teachers;
 - c. conduct individual projects to intercultural teaching; and
 - d. undertake other activities to enhance mutual understanding between Korean and the Philippines.
4. Eligible to apply are teachers who
 - a. must have at least three (3) years in minimum teaching experience;
 - b. have over ten (10) years remaining teaching term ; and
 - c. have not been a recipient of any Korean program funding
5. Applicants shall submit the following:
 - a. accomplished application form;
 - b. Transcript of Records; and
 - c. service record
6. Application form with documentary requirements shall be submitted to this office through the Professional Development Committee (PDC) c/o Ms. Marlyne M. Villareal of the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD) on or before **February 15, 2019**.
7. Attached hereto is the Memorandum from the Unnumbered Memorandum from the International Cooperation Office entitled, *Selection of Teachers and Host Schools for the 2019 Korea-Philippines Teacher Exchange Program (KPTEP)*.
8. Immediate dissemination is desired.

SUBJECT : **Selection of Teachers and Host Schools for the 2019 Korea-Philippines Teacher Exchange Programme (KPTEP)**

DATE : 4 February 2019

This refers to the Korea-Philippines Teacher Exchange Programme (KPTEP) which was launched in 2012 in line with the Asia-Pacific Teacher Exchange for Global Education and on the basis of the Cultural Agreement between the Republic of the Philippines and the Republic of Korea entered into force on 27 April 1973.

As member of the KPTEP Technical Working Group (TWG) we are requesting your assistance in the selection of the **fourteen (14) teachers** who will be joining this year's teacher exchange program to be deployed in selected Korean schools from 2 April 2019 to 28 June 2019 (89 days) as well as **seven (7) host schools**. On the other hand, fourteen (14) Korean teachers shall be deployed in the Philippines from 12 August to 29 November 2019 (109 days) .

The duties of the teachers include:

- Designing and conducting lessons on intercultural understanding and curriculum related to the subjects in collaboration with their mentor teachers
- Introducing Filipino culture to Korean students and teachers
- Conducting individual projects to intercultural teaching
- Undertaking other activities to enhance mutual understanding between Korea and the Philippines

The host schools shall:

- Ensure safety of exchange teachers during their stay;
- Arrange accommodation for exchange teachers;
- Provide classes to observe/assist/teach for 6 hours minimum each day
- Provide feedback on exchange teachers' educational activities; and
- Strengthen the atmosphere of hospitality and tolerance to cultural difference.

As a general requirement, all teachers must have at least three (3) years minimum teaching experience, over ten (10) years teaching term left and has not been a recipient of any Korean program funding.

list of names of the participating Filipino teachers, list of host schools and their corresponding profiles, must be submitted **on or before 18 February 2019** through an official letter sent to the International Cooperation Office and/or emailed to ico@deped.gov.ph. 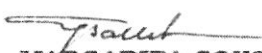

This is with reference to the recently conducted 2018 SSAEM (Sharing Stories of Asia-Pacific Education Movements) on November 29-30 2018 in Seoul, Korea which was attended by Ms. Maritel Bacsa of the Bureau of Curriculum Development and Ms. Eirish S. Zulueta of Las Piñas National High School. In the same event, a meeting was convened for all the six countries to give updates on the exchange programs with the Korean teachers.

The following agreements were reached after the discussions:

Programme Duration

- Invitation of Filipino teachers to Korea: 2 April 2019 – 28 June 2019 (89 days)
- Dispatch of Korean teachers to Philippines: 12 August 2019 – 29 November 2019 (109 days)
- Number of exchange teachers: 14 Filipino teachers, 14 Korean teachers

Dispatch of Korean teachers

- Region for dispatch and selection of host schools: NCR
- Teaching duration of Korean teachers in Filipino host schools: 6 hours minimum
- Korean teachers should follow host school regulations on working hours and are required to stay at host schools during their designated working hours.

Meeting Minutes - Consultation with DepEd Philippines

1. Programme Duration: discussed and confirmed by MOE Korea, DepEd, and APCEIU

- Invitation of Filipino teachers to Korea: 2 April – 28 June (89 days)
- Dispatch of Korean teachers to Philippines: 12 August – 29 November (109 days)
- Number of exchange teachers: 14 Filipino teachers, 14 Korean teachers

2. Dispatch of Korean teachers

- Region for the dispatch and selection of host schools
 - Due to the issues arisen in Region 3 and 4A in 2018 Programme, MOE, DepEd and APCEIU have decided to dispatch Korean teachers only in NCR.
- Regulation for Korean teachers
 - DepEd confirmed that the working hours at of Filipino host school is generally 7am to 4pm except for the schools in highly populated regions which have 2-shift system. For each day, teachers are required to teach classes for 6 hours minimum.
 - DepEd and APCEIU have confirmed that Korean teachers dispatched to the Philippines should follow the regulation of the host school on working hours, and they are required to stay at host schools during the designated working hours no matter they have classes or not.

3. Others

- There was a request from a Filipino mentor teacher that DepEd provide some additional privilege to mentor teachers participating in the Programme. DepEd will consider the feasibility of this suggestion.

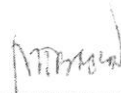
