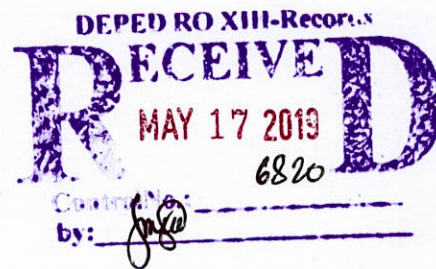

The participants of the said convention are the Biology Educators, researchers, practitioners and enthusiasts.

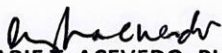
