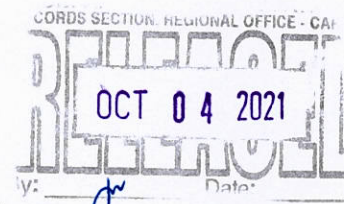

PREPAREDNESS MEASURES ON TROPICAL DEPRESSION "LANNIE"

As of today, October 4, 2021, 5:00AM, the Tropical Depression "Lannie" is at 100 km East of Surigao City, with maximum wind/gust of 45/55 km/h and moving Northwest at 20 km/h.

Areas with Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal (TCWS) No. 1 are Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Norte including Siargao Island, and the Northern portions of Agusan del Norte, Agusan del Sur, and Surigao del Sur.

TD "Lannie" may make landfall in the vicinity of Siargao-Bucas Grande Islands in the next six (6) hours and will move generally west northwestward and crossing Dinagat Islands and Visayas archipelago before emerging over the Sulu Sea tomorrow. It is estimated to exit the area of responsibility by Thursday.

However, TD "Lannie" may reach tropical storm category by Wednesday afternoon and severe tropical storm category by the end of the forecast period.

All Schools Division Offices are directed to ensure that all schools have conducted preparedness measures and the School DRRM Committees are on alert for possible damages in the school facilities and classrooms to be used as evacuation areas.

As usual, all schools with incurred damages in their school facilities are to submit a report to the CO-DRRM thru a text message (SMS) using the Rapid Assessment of Damages Report (RADAR) template sequence and shall submit the same report to their respective SDOs especially on classrooms used as Evacuation Centers.

SDOs shall submit the consolidated report of their schools to this office thru the Regional DRRM Coordinator. Reports shall be submitted to the megnon.beldad@deped.gov.ph. For any concerns, contact her at mobile phone no. (0910) 472-3654.
