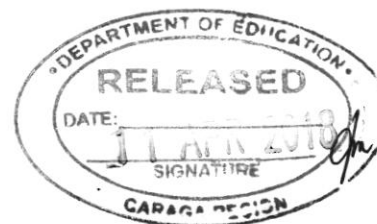

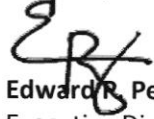

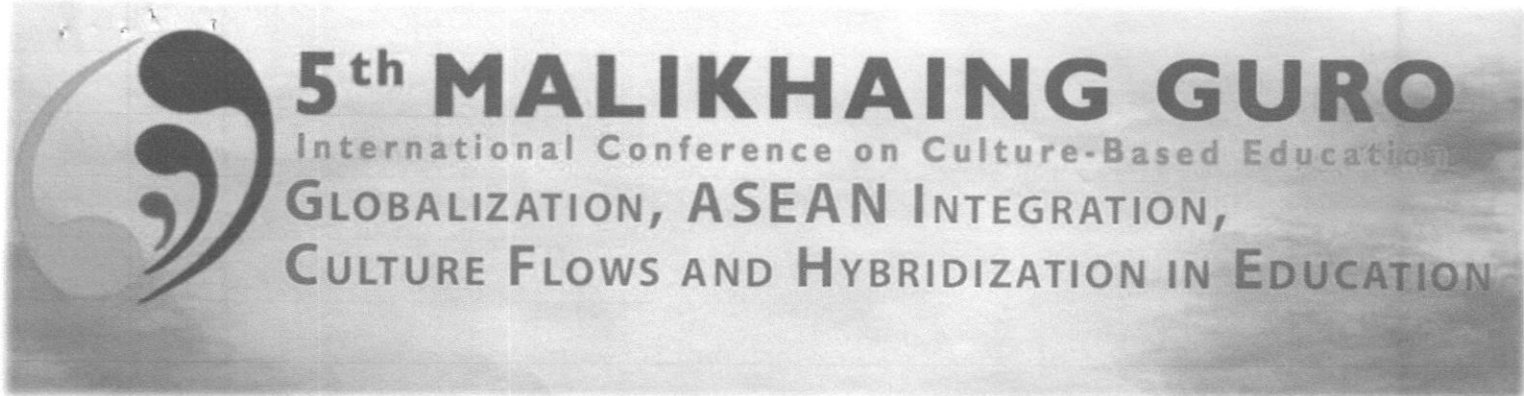

Guidelines for:

A. Presentations

- Abstract for proposed paper presentations must be received through email by the conference Secretariat on or before May 18, 2018. The abstract should not exceed 200 words, accompanied by a short author’s relevant professional and personal profile not exceeding 100 words.
- Presentations may also be in the form of poster or video of innovative culture-based lessons and instructional materials provided that they are supported by strong empirical evidence.
- Abstracts may be written in Filipino or English.

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- Full papers must adhere to the following:
 - i. Must NOT exceed 5,000 words, abstract is included
 - ii. Font Format: Times New Roman, 12, double space
 - Notice of acceptance of abstracts will be released on May 25, 2018.
 - Full papers, posters and videos of accepted abstracts must be submitted to the Conference Secretariat no later than June 15, 2018.
- B. Poster Presentations
- The poster must be 2.5 ft. wide and 5 ft. long.
 - Poster orientation must be portrait. The word count should NOT exceed 1,500 words and follow this format:
 - i. Title Text: Arial, 48-72
 - ii. Body Text: Arial, 28
 - All photos and infographics must be printed at 300 dots per inch (dpi) and should have proper photo credits.
 - References must be listed using APA citation.
- C. Video Presentation
- Video submissions must be in MP4 format and should only be between 3 to 5 minutes including the opening and ending credits.
 - Video presentations must contain English subtitles in Arial, 48. Subtitles may be in black or white, depending on what is more readable in your presentation.
 - Presenters are required to submit a copy of their presentation online through our official email mg2018presenter@gmail.com and a CD/DVD copy as well.
- D. Conference Registration
- Maximum of 200 slots will be allotted to participants from the Department of Education. Priority shall be given to teachers with defined research interest and willing to pursue research in the future.
 - Participants must register individually online on or before May 30 using this link: *(link to be posted on official facebook page @MGInternational)*
 - Conference fee is Php 3,000.00 per person and shall cover conference kit, ID and certificate. Conference fee must be paid upon registration. Please deposit your payment through any branch of Land Bank of the Philippines using the following details:
