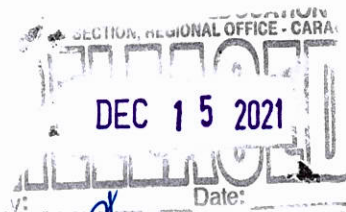

**PREPAREDNESS MEASURES OF DEPED OFFICES AND SCHOOLS
FOR TROPICAL STORM "ODETTE"**

In preparation for the tropical depression (which shall be called Tropical Storm Odette once it enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) on December 15, 2021, Wednesday), all DepEd offices and schools are directed to conduct preparedness measures in their areas, such as but not limited to:

1. send warnings and advisories to office and school personnel
2. cascade preparedness directives
3. recommend for suspension of travel of personnel should situation becomes worse
4. advise personnel and learners' family to pre-emptively evacuate to safer grounds/location
5. activate School DRRM Committees for monitoring of possible damages and/or casualties
6. coordinate with LGUs for any advisories and/or weather updates

Per Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) Analyst Groups Findings, all provinces in Caraga are exposed to tropical cyclone, susceptible to landslides, flooding, and unpassable roads/bridges. Caraga Region may experience Wind Signal No. 3 effects/impacts.

Lastly, SDOs and schools are reminded that reports on this weather disturbance are expected within 72 hours after the landfall.
