PROCLAMATION NO. 002
Series of 2021

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, the Republic Act of the Philippines thru Republic Act 10121 and the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council provided for all the necessary guidelines needed to plan, implement and respond to all disasters;

WHEREAS, as per PAGASA's Tropical Cyclone Bulletin No. 2 for Severe Tropical Storm ODETTE issued at 5:00 AM on December 15, 2021. "ODETTE" SLIGHTLY INTENSIFIES AND IS NEARING TYPHOON CATEGORY IN STRENGTH. Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal No.1 categorized as Strong winds prevailing or expected within 36 hours for Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Norte, Surigao del Sur, Agusan del Norte and Agusan del Sur;

WHEREAS, as part of our proactive measures and in order to prevent any untoward incident including loss of lives and properties, pursuant to Section 3 of Executive Order No. 66, s. 2012 entitled "**PRESCRIBING RULES ON THE CANCELLATION OR SUSPENSION OF CLASSES AND WORK IN GOVERNMENT OFFICES DUE TO TYPHOON, FLOODING, OTHER WEATHER DISTURBANCES, AND CALAMITIES**" there is an urgent need to suspend classes on all levels in public and private schools and suspend work in the City Government of Butuan including all government activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ENGR. RONNIE VICENTE C. LAGNADA, City Mayor of Butuan, by the authority vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. *Suspension of classes on all levels in public and private schools and work in the City Government of Butuan including all government activities.* Classes in public and private schools on all levels and work in government offices shall be suspended beginning 1:00 PM on Wednesday (December 15, 2021) until further notice.

SECTION 2. *Private offices and establishments* are also encouraged to adopt the suspension of work to ensure safety of all their employees and families.

SECTION 3. *Maintenance of Work Force.* The following City Government of Butuan personnel and/or office, particularly those directly involved in disaster risk reduction and management, peace and order, infrastructure, health, and social services shall report to





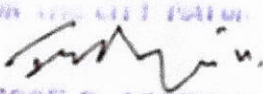
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the Emergency Operation Center and maintain the operations of their respective offices to ensure the continuity of the delivery of services to the public during the entire course of the emergency operation to wit:

1. City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office
2. City Social Welfare and Development Office
3. City Health Office
4. City Environment and Natural Resources Office
5. City Engineer's Office
6. City General Services Office
7. City GAD Focal
8. City Nutrition Office
9. City Agriculturist Office
10. City Veterinary Office
11. Public Information Office

SECTION 4. Effectivity. This Proclamation shall take effect immediately and shall be in force until revoked by the undersigned.
