- Participants must be a team composed of three (3) youth members (aged 18-30 years old).
Each participating team may represent a school / club / organization / association or can be a stand-alone team. SK Federation members may participate given that they will not be part of the working committee.
- All members of the participating teams must be a resident of Agusan del Norte.
- Both existing MSMEs/group or youth members with existing businesses or aspiring *youthpreneurs* are allowed to participate.
- The submitted business plan should be on a business idea that adds value to existing products or service innovation that will be in line with the province's economic agenda/priority industry clusters under its 8th point development plan: Agusan UP. These priority industries are the following:
 - Abaca
 - Aquamarine
 - Banana
 - Cacao
 - Cassava
 - Coconut
 - Coffee
 - Mango
 - Rubber
 - Wood
- Only 10 qualified registrants will be able to join the bootcamp and competition.
