April 22, 2021		- formulate possible outcomes of the investigation, or in the case of mathematics research, conjectures about the mathematical problem or topic - design a strategy or sequence of steps that will address the scientific question at hand - select appropriate methods of data collection - develop the criteria that will address the completeness of the data collection method
May 27, 2021		- analyze the data obtained from the investigation - draw logical conclusions supported by processed data - make recommendations that are relevant to the study

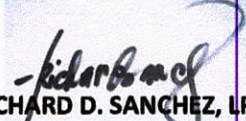
Post-webinar activities will be given by each of the lecturers and to be complied with/submitted by the participants for the issuance of the Certificate of Participation.
