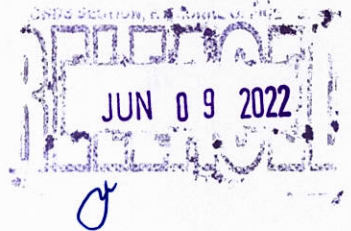

Gender Fair Education (GFE) is a foundational course that introduces basic concepts in Gender and Development (GAD), Gender-Fair Inclusive Language (GFIL), Gender-Responsiveness, and how GFIL plays an important role in the aspect of human relations and gender-based perspectives as manifested in the educational, development work and other teaching-learning settings. Topics include education as human rights, gender-fair inclusive language, gender mainstreaming in the curriculum, and the effective implementation of GAD mandates in educational institutions and development organizations. The training sessions make use of interactive hands-on approaches to enhance learning-by-doing.
