We are writing to partner with the Department of Education – Caraga through the Divisions of Cabadbaran City, Bayugan City and Tandag City in the conduct of our **Kabataan Karapatan Caravan - Webinar on Children's Cyber Safety**. This webinar is one the Commission's lined events for this year's Children's Month Celebration.
