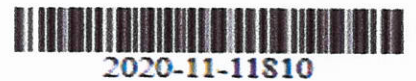

The following are the mechanics for the said contest:

- The contest is open to Caraganons and has two categories, the Gen Z category wherein participants must be 5-24 years of age and the Millennial category wherein participants must be 25-40 years old.
- Submission of entries is from October 27, 2020 to 5:00 PM of November 20, 2020. Each participant is allowed to submit two (2) entries in their corresponding category. Entries shall be submitted to da13caragainto@gmail.com and shall include the following details:
 - A. Name, Sex, Age, Mailing Address, Contact Number
 - B. Photo Title
 - C. Photo Caption (1-2 sentences describing the photo and the relevance to the theme)
 - D. Place where the photo was taken (containing the name of the barangay, town/municipality, city, province, and region)
 - E. Date when photo was taken
 - F. Category
 - G. Device used (specs)
- File name of photos should be in the following format: (Surname, First Name, Middle Initial) eg. (DELACRUZ, Juan Miguel, S.). Subject of the email for entries should in the following format: (Category, Surname, First Name, Middle Initial) eg.(Gen Z Category, Delacruz, Juan Miguel, S.)
- Photos to be submitted should have been taken from October 21, 2020 – November 20, 2020.
- All photos must be original and must not contain copyrighted materials, violence, and nudity.
- Only colored photos shall be considered. Black and Sepia photos will be disqualified.
- For Gen Z category, photos must be in JPG format regardless of dpi count as long as the photos are in full HD. For millennial category, photos shall be at least 300 dpi and maximum file size of 30MB.
- Major manipulation of images through adding or subtracting are not allowed. However, digital retouching on density, contrast adjustments, minor cropping, burning, and dodging may be allowed.
- Watermarked photos and those that have won in any competition will be disqualified.
