About the Convention

The NCS, organized by the PSS and spearheaded by the PSA, is conducted every three years and aims to:

- 1) provide a forum for practitioners and theoreticians in the field of statistics to discuss prevailing issues and emerging developments affecting the PSS; and
- 2) elicit the cooperation and support of statisticians and professionals in related fields from the government, academe and private sector towards a more responsive statistical system.

15th NCS Theme

This year, the 15th NCS will coincide with the opening of the 33rd National Statistics Month (NSM) celebration on 03 October 2022. The 15th NCS will feature plenary sessions, invited/contributed paper sessions, poster sessions, panel discussions, statistical trainings, and the Statistical Information Management Exhibit (SIMEx).
