Attached herewith for your reference is DepEd Advisory No. 140 s. 2019 and steps on how to register on-line.

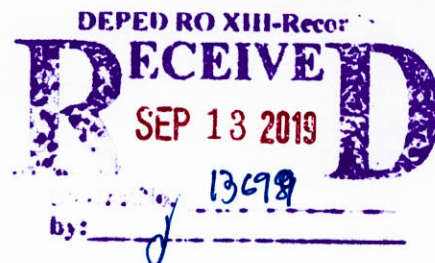

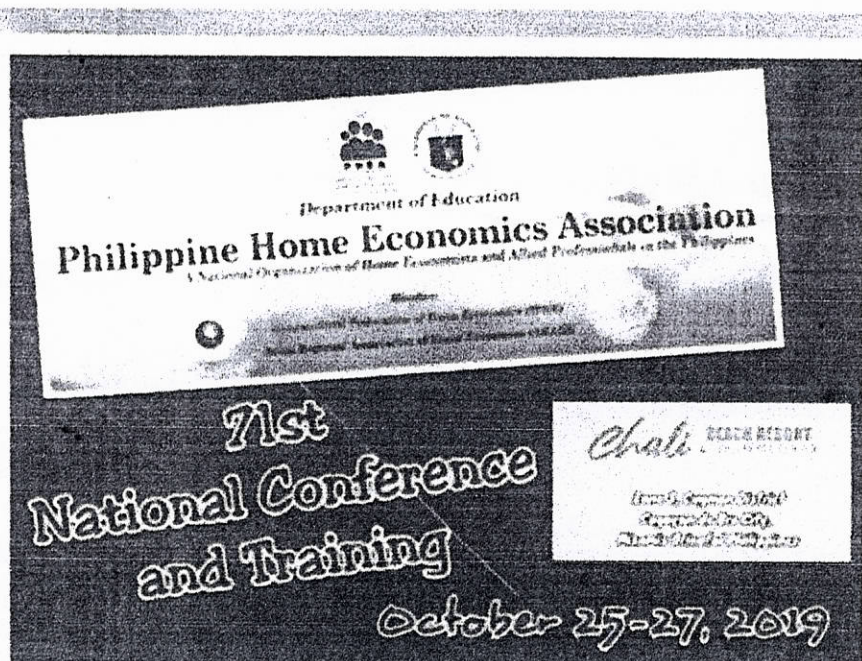
