1. A part of celebrating 35th ASEAN Council of Teachers, DepEd Memorandum No. 119, s. 2019, DepEd Caraga Region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct the 9th ASEAN QUIZ REGIONAL LEVEL on October 18, 2019 at RELC 2, Bulwagan ng Karunungan, Butuan City.
2. The objective of this quiz is to foster the spirit of healthy competition among the youth of the secondary school level of the 12 divisions in a friendly quiz game that exposes them to various ASEAN cultural, political, economic and social information.
3. All division offices are encouraged to conduct the Division Level Competition to determine the official one (1) contestant who shall represent the division and compete in the Regional level competition.
4. The Regional ASEAN Quiz could be participated by male or female learners in Grades 9-10 between fifteen (15) to seventeen (17) years old; must not be 18 years old by the time of the Regional Competition which will be held in the first quarter of 2020; come from either a public or private school; be proficient in the English language, both oral and written; have a grade of 85 and above in Social Studies in the first quarter of School Year 2019-2020; have good interpersonal skills/ be a good team player; and be physically fit.
5. The aforementioned qualifications shall also be observed in the division and regional level competition.
6. Participants of the said activity are found at Enclosure 1.
7. Contestants and coaches are expected to arrive at the contest venue at **7:00 A.M.** and should be in school uniform and register on line until October 14, 2019 at <http://bit.ly/ASEANQUIZ>
8. The participants should submit photocopied **Travel Authority** signed by the **Schools Division Superintendent** upon signing the attendance and registration form at the secretariat.
9. Expenses to be incurred during the division search shall be charged to local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
